Sri.Y.N.College has adopted Ponnapalli, Kotavaddapalem and Nandamuri Colony slum areas, which are predominantly fishermen community areas in Narsapur Town, as part of college outreach programme. Funds for this programme are being met from college management and CPE Grants from UGC. New Delhi.

Aims and Objectives of the programme:

- To improve literacy rate and to give financial support to economically weak and deserving school going children.
- 2. To conduct Vocational Training programme (Swayamkrish Centre) for school dropouts, orphan girls and needy women for self employment.
- 3. To organize literacy, health, sanitation and awareness programmes.
- To take relief measures, rehabilitation and reconstruction programmes aimed at the development of people or areas affected by natural calamities.
- 5. To organize RO mineral water plant for public to the low price.

Activities:

1. Distribution of Bicycles: On 15-08-2018 Under Community Service Centre programme of our college, distributed 60 Bicycles to our college students of Intermediate and Degree girl students.

- 2. Distribution of blankets and Fruits: On 29-11-2018 Distribution of blankets and Fruits to the Old Women at the Bondamma old age home, Narasapur
- 3. Distribution of Sewing Machines: On 26-01-2019 Ten Sewing machines distributed by our college to trained women of our Swayamkrish centre. Those who belonged to Ponnapalli, Kotavaddapalem and Nandamuri colony slum areas.
