## MOU IN CORINGA FOREST



It is the third largest stretch of mangrove forests in India with 24 mangrove tree species and more than 120 bird species.

All the plants can be survive with help of the salted water

Coringa mangrove forest is located in the Godavari delta, Andhra Pradesh, India. The mangrove community consisted of more than 13 species of mangrove and other plants in the present study area.

The Coringo ecosystem is formed at the confluence of the Gowthami-Godavari river with the Bay of Bengal. It is **an estuarine ecosystem and consists of mangrove swamps**. Since the sea and freshwater meet in this region there are periodic tides which bring rich nutrients.
