It is decided to offer the MA English Language and Literature programme which shall be as is the normal in all universities – in Two years, in the Semester mode, with 2 Semesters each in the First and Second years. That is to say the programme will have 4 Semesters. Each Semester shall have five papers each. That is to say the programme will have 20 Papers of Study all together. All papers in the First, Second and Third Semesters are Core Papers and in the Fourth (Final) Semester, along with the Core Courses/Papers. Elective Courses are offered While the first four papers shall be core papers, the fifth paper shall be an Elective paper (to be chosen by the students from the four choice areas given). The Elective is also called Specialization area.
