Poetry as a medium has come to be replaced by prose. The earlier Five Act structure has yielded Place to the Three Act Domestic Drama. The Two Act Absurd Drama, and even the One Act Drama. Though one Act dramas can be read as a separate genre all by itself.</p> <p>The European Drama and the Japanese Drama offered a wide variety to practitioners, the critics and the audience alike. Strange and interesting deviations have been attempted by dramatists galore. Pirandello, Brecht, Pinter, Beckett, Ionesco, Adamov, Genet, Miller, O'Neill among others have opened new possibilities for Drama. The Japanese Drama with its varied forms like Noh, Kabuki and Bunraku has influenced many modern dramatists profoundly. Added to these we have the shadow and Puppet Theatre in many in particular in India and Japan. In Japan the Puppet Theatre is called 'Nagyo-Ioruru'. Strange as it may sound to the man in the street there are in the last half century more than three hundred dramas in Sanskrit which is unfortunately mistaken as a dead language. To cite an example Gyan-giri 'Awarade' late Sri Viswanadha Satyanarayana's 'Gupta Pasupatham' is</p>	<p>reinterpretation of the Mahabharata. What is even more astonishing and relevant is that a sizable proportion of contemporary Sanskrit Theatre is devoted to social problems. The Telugu Drama has lots of social reforms in it. 'Kanya Sukham' being an outstanding example. Other Indian languages have not lagged behind. They made use of more than one genre for their launch. The International Seminar proposed to be held at Sri Y.N.
