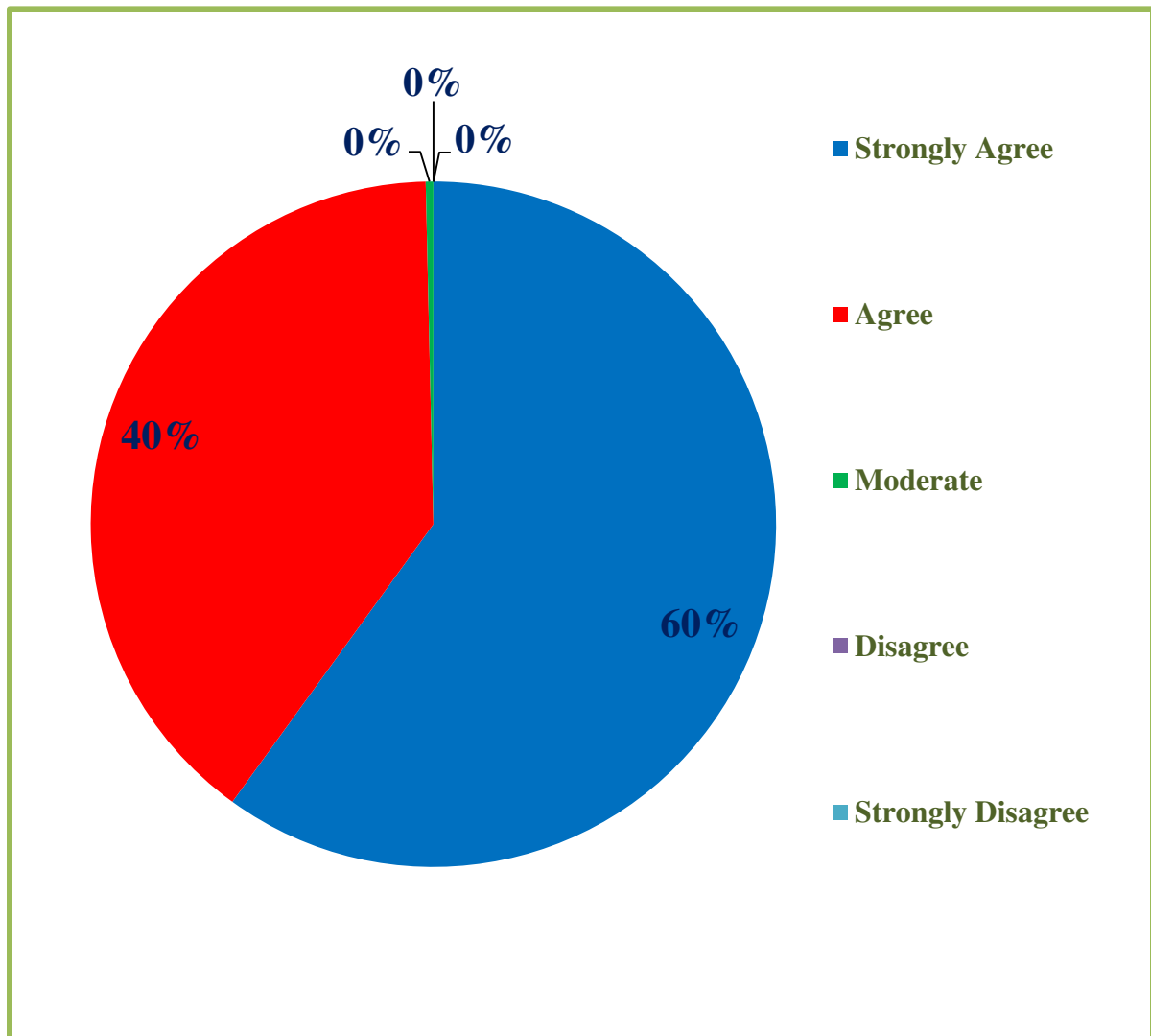

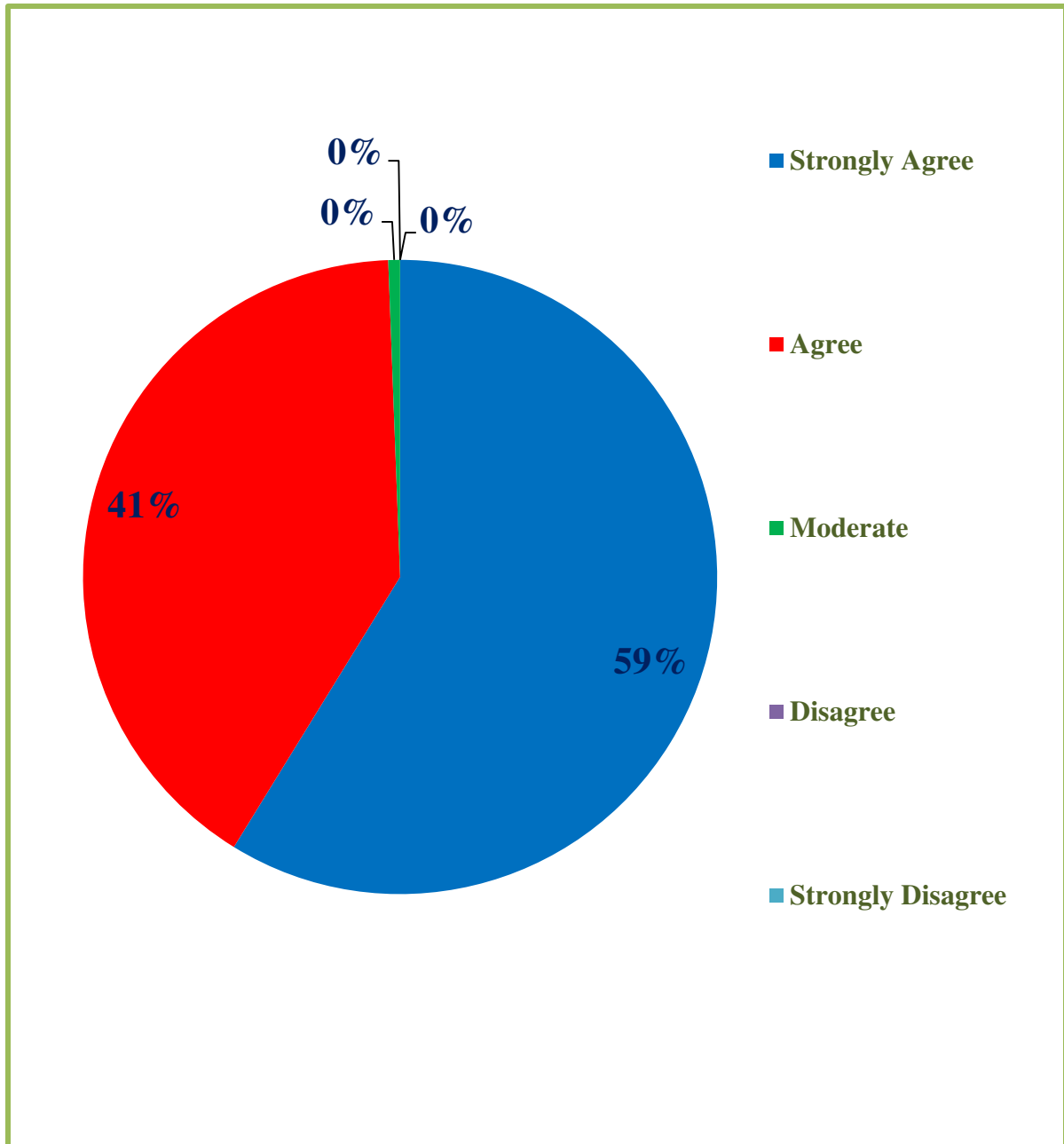
1. The syllabus of all Courses in the semester is well structured.

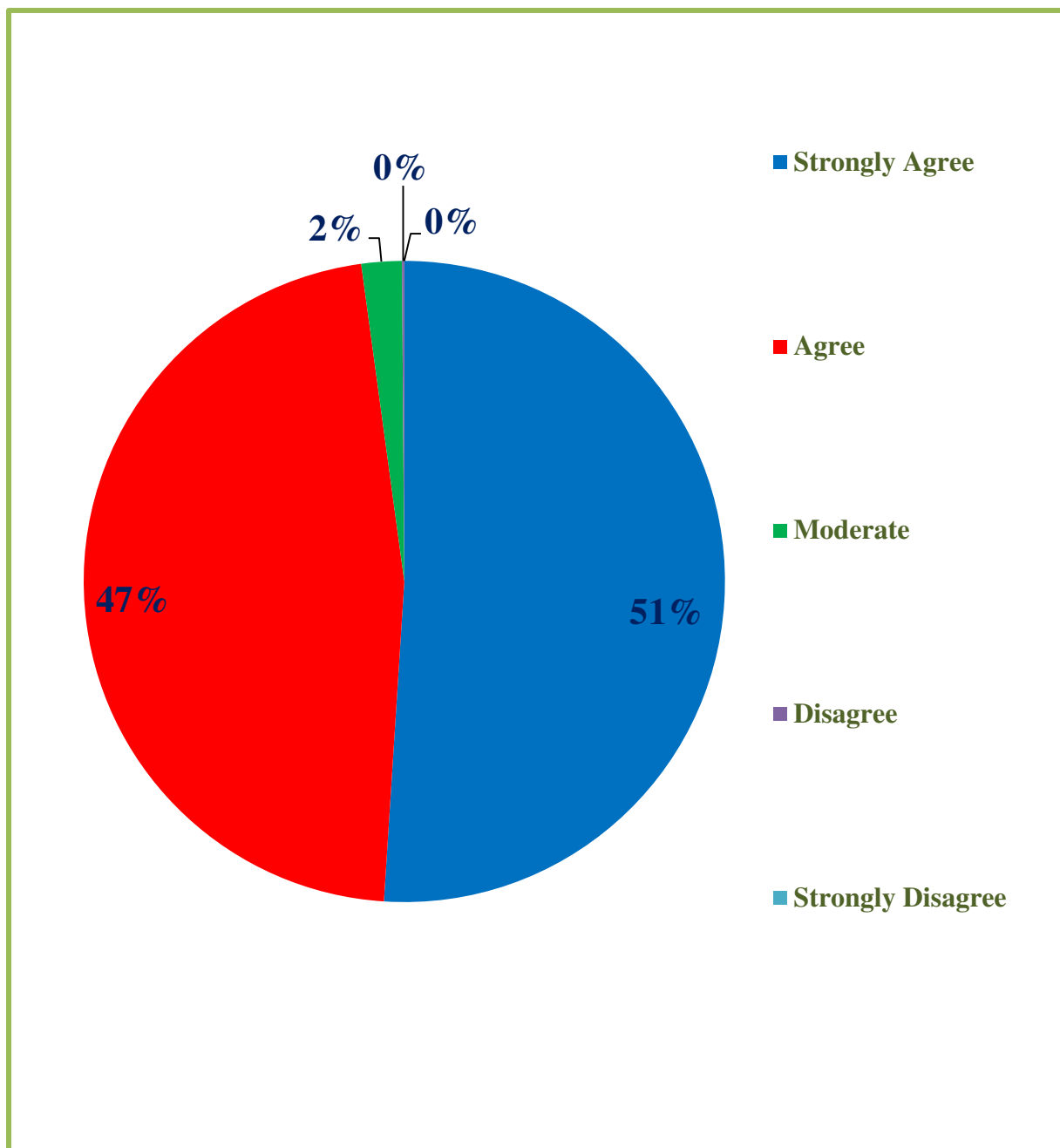
2. The syllabus is interesting.

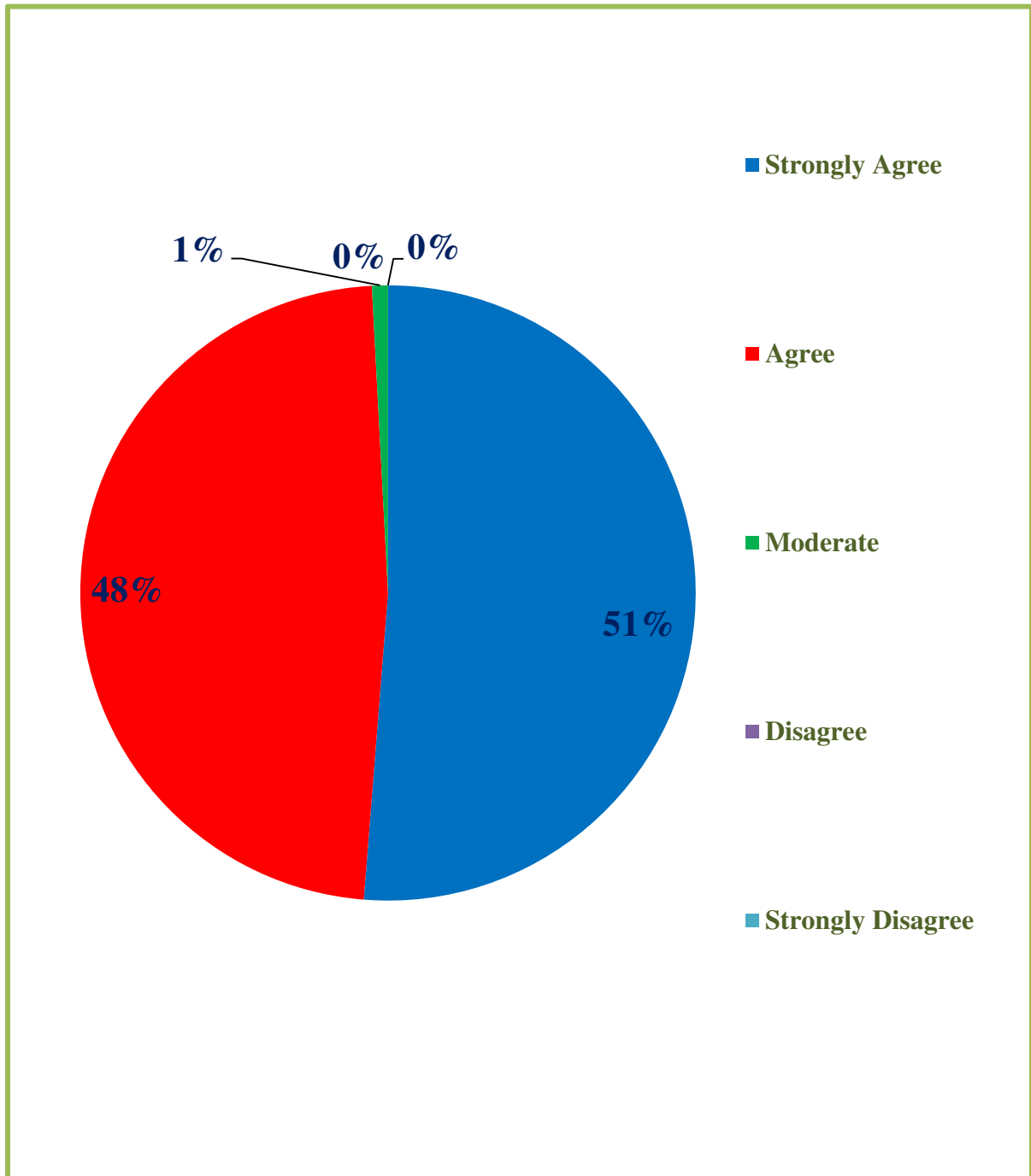
3. The syllabus has ample scope for practical skills and exposure.

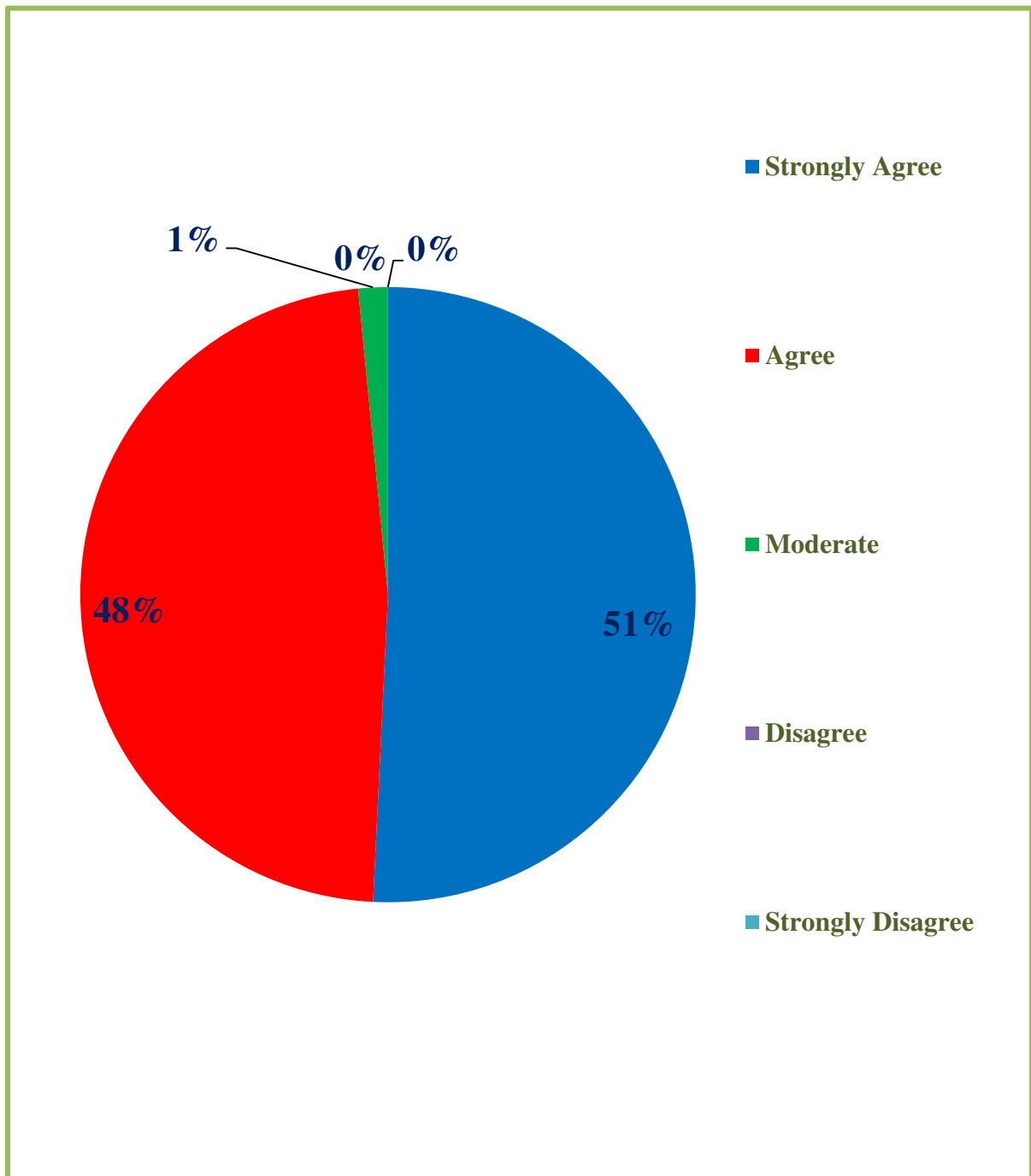

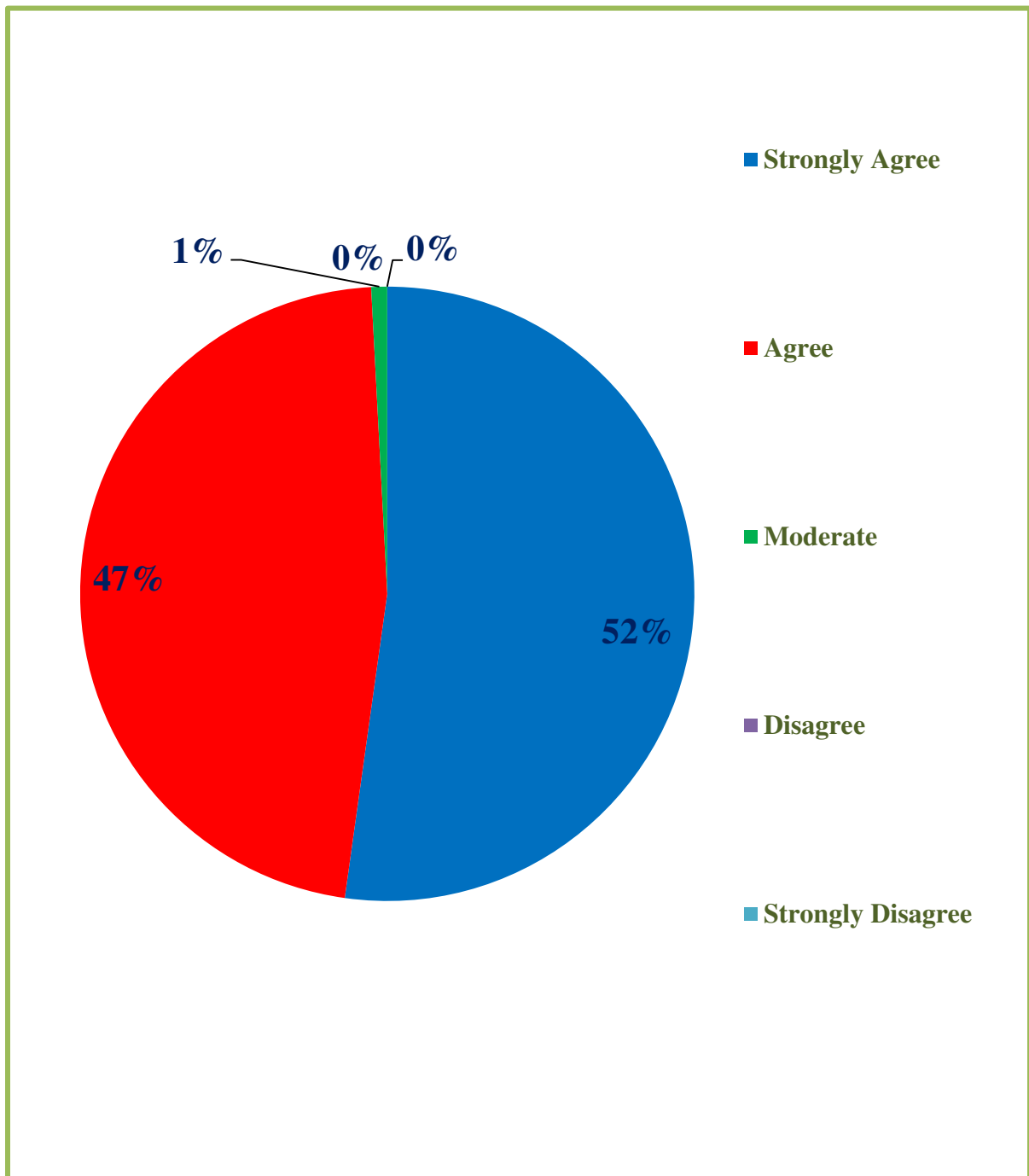

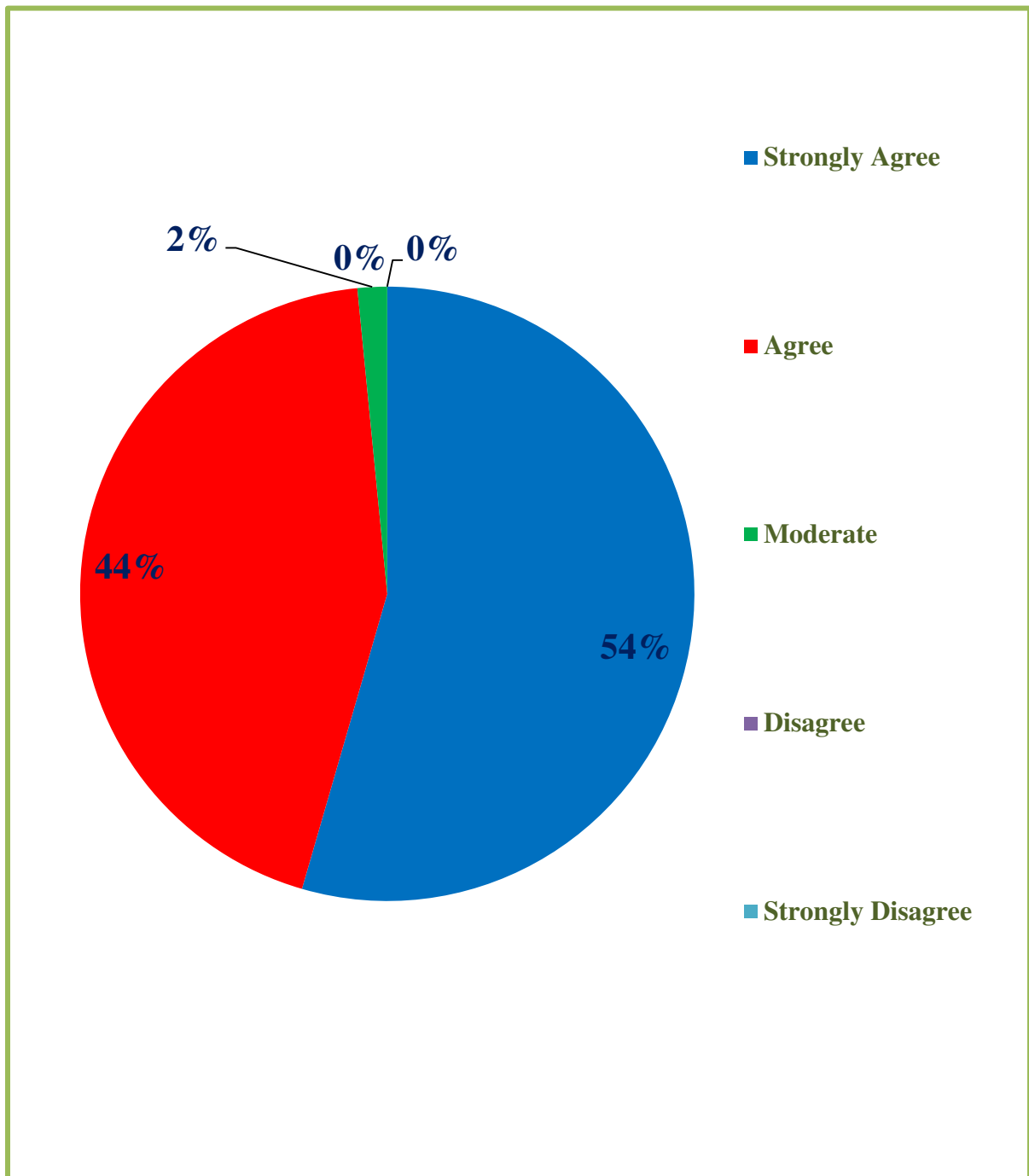
6. The syllabus is easy to understand.

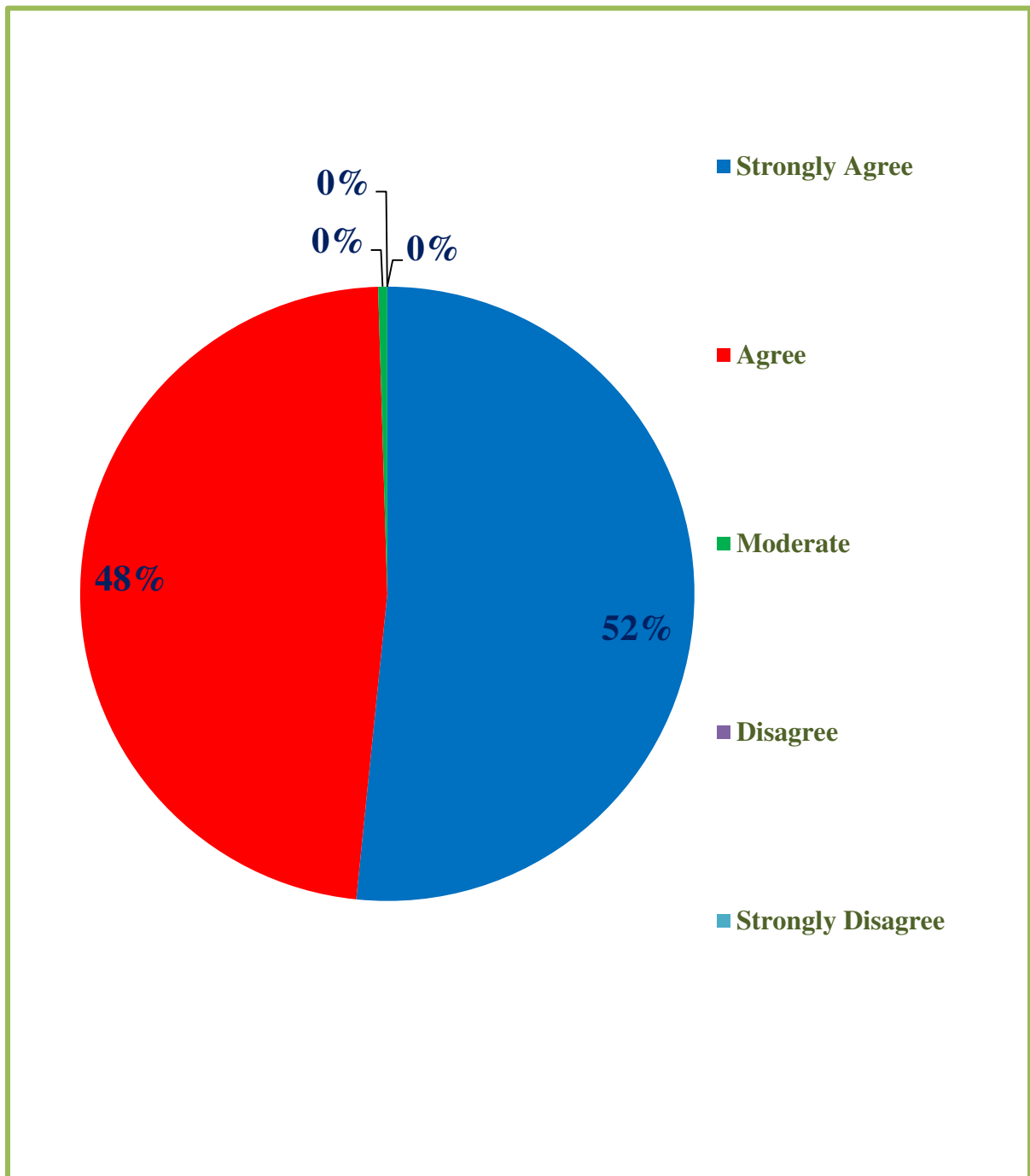
7. The syllabus has scope for Employability Skills.

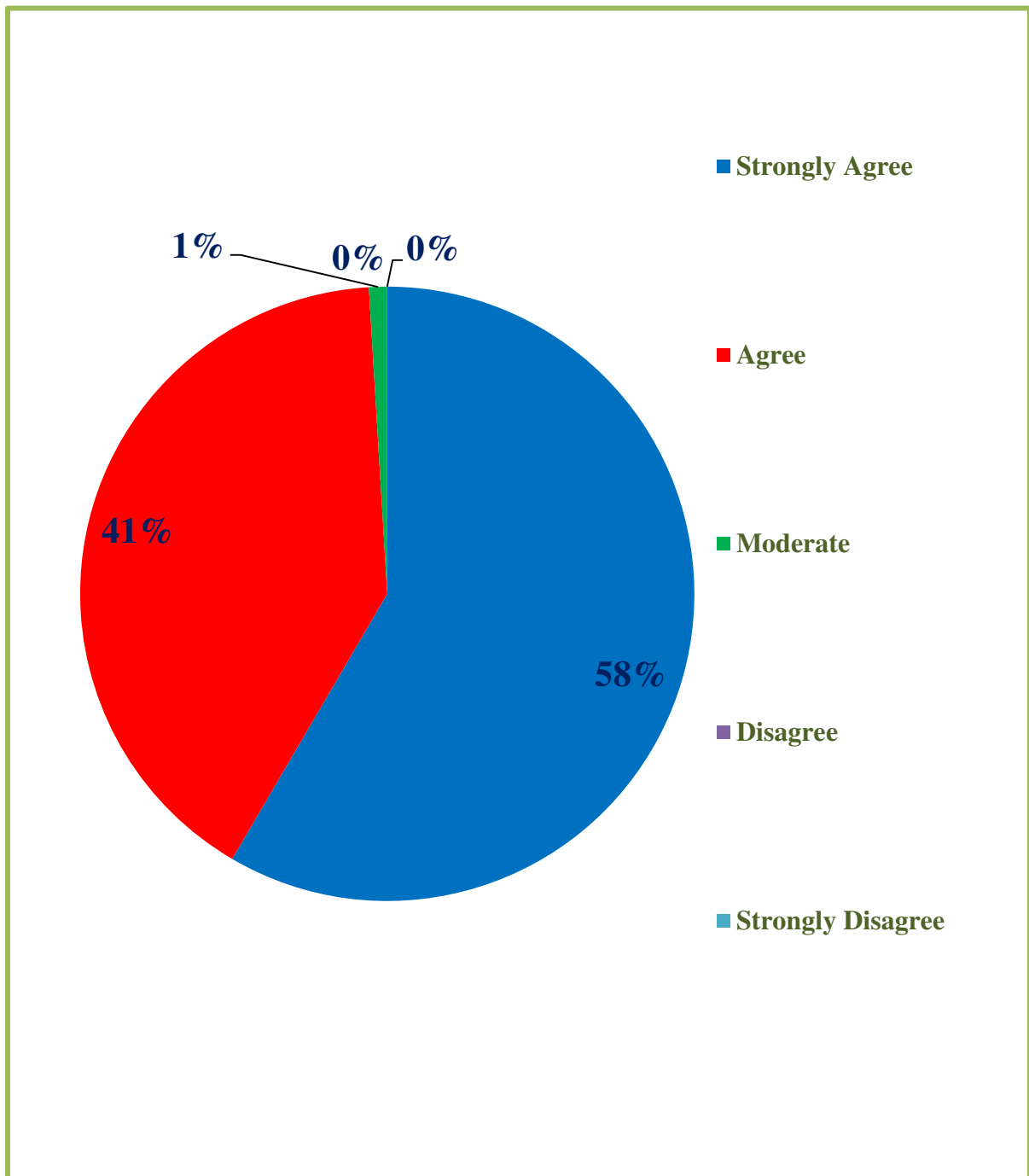
