ABOUT THE COLLEGE :

Narsapur, a small semi - urban coastal town is situated on the banks of the sacred river Vasishtha Godeavari in West Godavari District of Andhra Pradesh. Sri Yerramilli Narayana Murthy College, Narsapur was established in the year 1949 with the noble cause of serving people in the field of higher education. Campus women's hostels, a Spacious Play Ground, Indoor Stadium, Multi Gym and Auditorium are some of the Prestigious wings of our college.

With the valuable support, guidance and assistance rendered by Andhra University and Adikavi Nannayya University, UGC, AICTE and Commissioner of Collegiate Education and other education authorities, the college evolved as a premier institute of Higher Education.

The College is offering 7 PG courses- MBA, MCA, M.Sc (Organic Chemistry), M.Sc (Mathematics), M.A(English), M.A (Public Administration) and 17 UG courses.

ABOUT THE DEPARTMENT:

Department of Biology came into existence in the year 1949 with Sri G.Sri Rama Murthy as the Head of the Department, who worked till 1952. He was succeeded by Late Sri N.V.Rao.

Subsequently Botany wing was separated from the Biology department. Late Sri N.V.Rao was the first Head of the Newly formed Botany Department. His untiring efforts employed with utmost perseverance have resulted in formation of separate lab facilities for degree and intermediate classes. He was also responsible for the museum with well mounted specimens, majority of which were collected by the staff and a herbarium with rich and rare collection of specimens.

The Department is located in the area of 272 Sq mts (2928 Sq ft) having good laboratory facilities.

The equipment range include 73 compound microscopes, One Microtome, Epidiascope, A Slide Projector, Overhead Projector, Research Microscope, Two Projection Microscopes and One Stereo Microscope, Digital Eye Microscope with LCD TV, Distillation Unit, Moisture Tester, Rain Gauge, Anemo Meter, Lux Meter, Gel Electrophoresis, High Speed Centrifuge, Water Bath, 58 Dissection Microscopes.

SCOPE:

The Medicinal plants are closely connected with the traditional knowledge of its use. During the early periods the knowledge of medicinal properties of the plants was transferred from one generation to another generation orally and no documentation of the Medicinal Plants have been maintained. It is essential to evaluate the herbal plant scientifically and documents should to be made to know their medicinal properties. A great demand of herbal medicines in the developed as well as developing countries because of their wide biological activities, higher safety margin with compared with synthetic drugs.

Promotion of cultivation and conservation of medicinal plants.


To identify the plants to be cultivated in-situ at the different agro climatic regions of the state and those to be cultivated in the fields.




