


1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?


2. Are the teachers preparing well for the classes?


3. What do you say about your teachers communication skills?


4. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as


5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers.


6. Was your performance in assignments discussed with you?


7. The institute takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit opportunities for students.


8. The teaching and mentoring process in the institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth.


9. The institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow.


10. Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes


11. Do your teachers counsel you in the academic issues?

12. Do your teachers use illustrations & examples?



13. The teachers identify your strengths and encourage you with providing right level of challenges.



14. Do your teachers help you to overcome your weaknesses?




15. The institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process.


16. The institute/ teachers use student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences.


17. Teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities.


18. Efforts are made by the institute/ teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work.


19. What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc. while teaching.

(B) Action Taken Report

Sri Y N College values student feedback and is committed to continually improving the Teaching Learning and Evaluation process. We have carefully considered the suggestions received from students and have taken the following steps to address their concerns.

1. Suggestion- Availability of Microsoft Online Certifications: The College should provide information and resources for students to obtain Microsoft Online Certifications in relevant fields to enhance professional skills.

Action Taken: Microsoft Upskilling Programme Nodal Officer reached out the Andhra Pradesh State Council of Higher Education (APSCHE) for providing free access to Microsoft Online Certifications for students. The Centre for Digital Learning and Innovation (CDLI) also made arrangements for training sessions for students to learn about the certification process and its benefits.

2. Suggestion-Incorporating more hands-on learning opportunities: Students have reported a lack of hands-on learning experiences and opportunities to apply the concepts they have learned in class.

Action Taken: Sri Y N College has partnered with local businesses and organizations to provide internship opportunities for students in various fields. Project-based learning activities have been introduced in several courses, allowing students to apply the concepts they have learned in a practical setting.

3. Suggestion-Development of Critical Thinking and Problem Solving Skills:

Action Taken: The College IQAC Coordinator has incorporated activities and exercises that encourage critical thinking and problem-solving in the curriculum. Faculty members have been trained on the use of case studies, simulations, and real-world examples to foster critical

thinking and problem-solving skills. Course syllabi have been updated to incorporate critical thinking and problem-solving activities.

4. Suggestion- Providing more support for students with different learning styles:

Students have expressed a need for a more personalized approach to learning that takes into account their individual learning styles and needs.

Action Taken: Introduced a tutoring program for students who need additional support in a particular subject. Personalized study plans have been developed for students based on their individual learning styles and needs. Alternative assessment methods, such as portfolios and presentations, have been incorporated into several courses to accommodate different learning styles.

5. Suggestion-Improving the availability of resources: Some students have reported difficulty accessing textbooks, online materials, and other resources necessary for their courses.

Action Taken: Sri Y N College has increased its budget for library materials and provided more digital resources for students, including online databases and e-books. The library and computer labs have been upgraded to improve accessibility for students, including extended hours and increased technology resources.


6. Suggestion-Providing more opportunities for students to engage in research: Many students have expressed a desire to participate in research activities, but have limited opportunities to do so.

The college has also provided students with opportunities to participate in hands-on projects, group work, and other active learning experiences.
