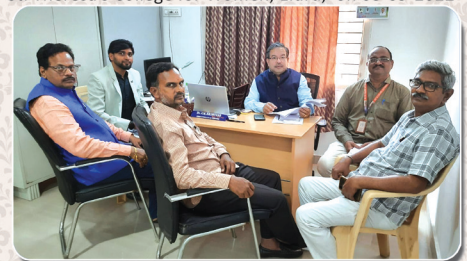

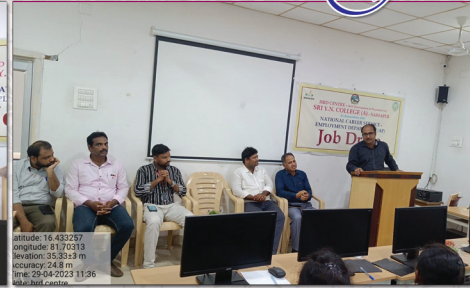

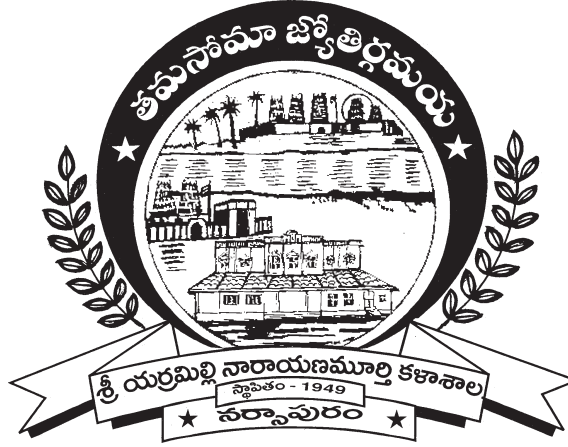

PRINCIPAL'S ANNUAL REPORT 2022-23

I am extremely happy to present the annual report of our prestigious institution for the academic year 2022-23. Our college offers 20 programmes at the UG level, 5 programmes at the PG level and 9 courses at the Intermediate level. The present student strength of the College is 2674, which includes 1740 in UG, 373 in PG, 483 in Intermediate and 78 in B.Ed. In addition, 250 Students in UG and 150 in PG joined AU Distance Education during this academic year.

The College has a very competent and experienced faculty with 20 Doctorates and 15 M.Phils. We have registered a pass percentage of 62% in B.Sc., 77% in B.Com., 67% in BBA and 97% in B.A. and an average of 68% during the Fifth Semester End Examinations in March 2023. National Education Policy (NEP) - 2020 has been implemented from the academic year 2020-21 onwards. Community Service Project (CSP) at the end of the first year, Short Term Internship at the end of the second year and Semester Internship during 6th semester are the new introduction to the regular

curriculum.

Our college conducts Faculty Development Programme (FDP) at the beginning of every academic year to enable the staff to refresh and for a good beginning. In this connection, the IQAC organized a Week FDP Programme "Paradigms of Outcome-based Teaching and Learning" from 6th to 11th June 2022. Dr. C. S. Rao, Secretary & Correspondent, delivered the Inaugural address to the gathering. Prof. B. Ramesh, Former Dean, Academic Affairs, Goa University, Goa, addressed the gathering on the second day. Prof. S.V.J.K. Kishore, Satyabhama University, Chennai, addressed the gathering in the FN session on the third day. 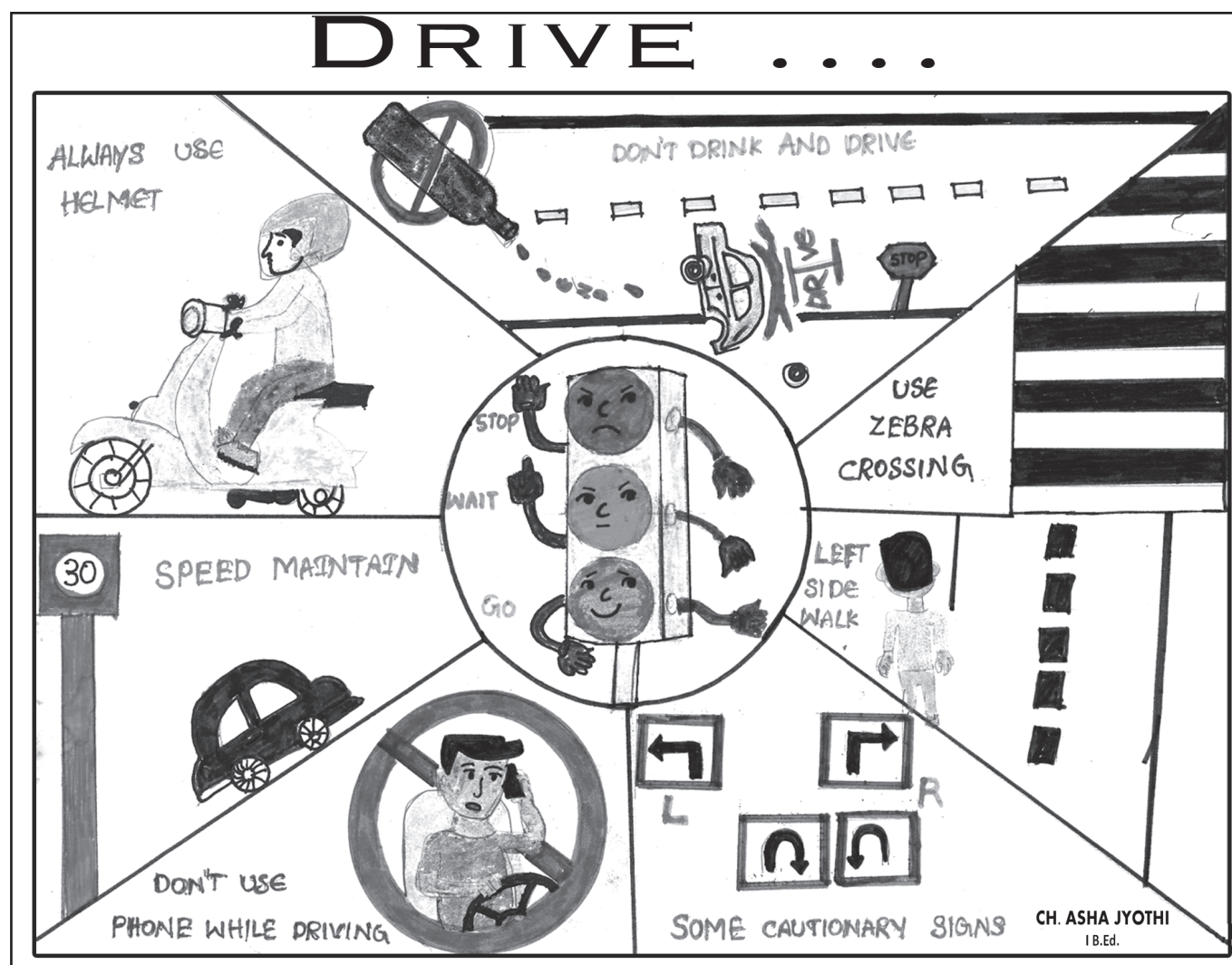
On 11-01-2023, Rangoli competition was conducted in the college campus on the occasion of "Sankranti" festival. A good number of students participated in the competitions and won prizes.

the gathering and detailed about the NIC Camp.

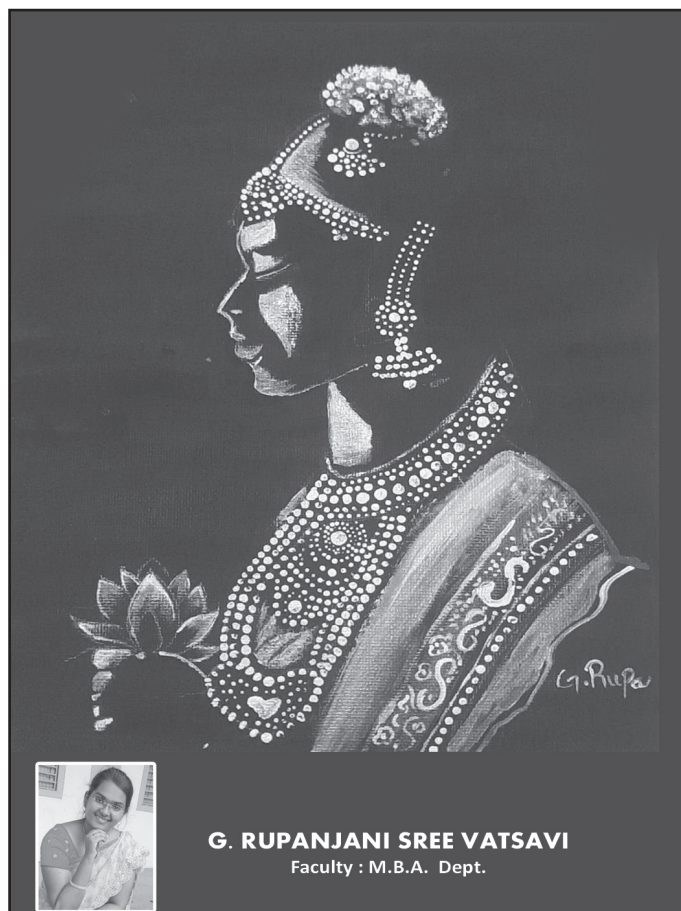

FREEDOM FIGHTER RANI LAKSHMI BAI

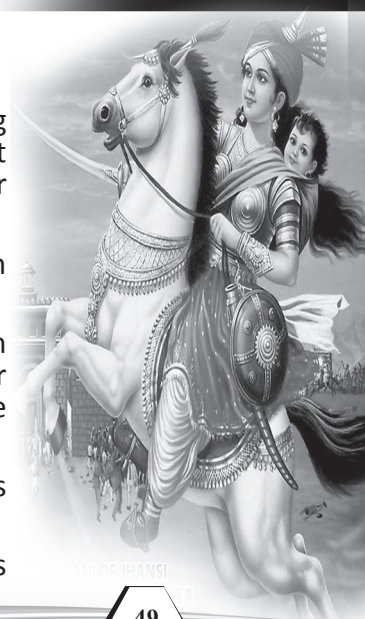

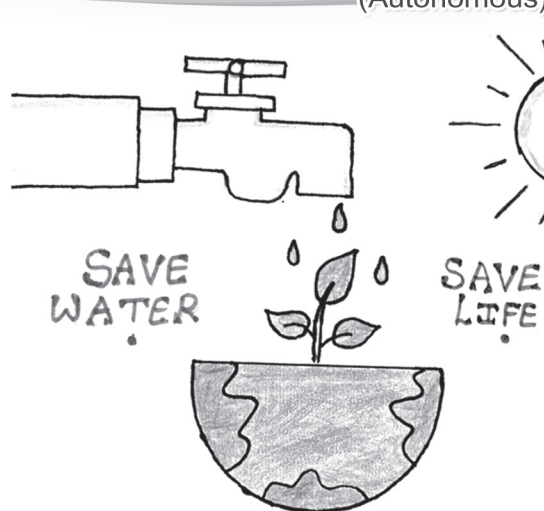
Marriages and adoption without their consent. Generally people bear injustice and violence and never inform to proper authority

The punishment is 7 years rigorous imprisonment life long with penalty for immoral trafficking without warrant the police officer shall investigate the case and collect the necessary details to protect the trafficked children and punish the accused.

The Dowry Prohibition Act 1961

If any person gives or takes or abets dowry he/she shall be punishable with imprisonment for term which shall not be less than 5 years, and with the fine which shall not be less than 15 thousand rupees or the amount of the value of such dowry whichever is more. It is observed that after the marriage the bride is teased, scolded, abused, beaten even sometimes cause for death or makes her commit suicide. All these offences cover in this act.

- 1) Enlisting the offerings.
- 2) Offering can't be demanded.
- 3) The offerings that are being provided must be as per one's cultural norms and traditions. The value of the offerings shall not be over & above of the parent's economic status and never become a burden to the family. Where there is such violence, the victim herself or her father / mother / brother / relatives can complain in the local police station.

20వ శతాబ్దంలో ప్రపంచ ప్రసిద్ధి గాంచిన గణిత మేధావులలో ఒకరు. ఈయన తమిళనాడులో ఈరోడ్ లోని ఓ నిరుపేద బ్రాహ్మణ కుటుంబానికి చెందిన కొమళమ్మ, శ్రీనివాస్ అయ్యంగారు దంపతులకు 1887 డిసెంబరు 22న రామానుజన్ జన్మించారు. చిన్న వయస్సులోనే అసాధారణ ప్రతిభను ప్రదర్శించి అయిరన్నే నియమించి, ప్రతికోణమితికి చెందిన ఎన్నో సమస్యలను అలవోకగా సాధించారు. జి.ఎస్. కార్ రచించిన “సినాప్పిన్ ఆఫ్ ప్యూర్ మెథమెటిక్” అనే పుస్తకం శ్రీనివాస్ రామానుజన్ లోని ప్రతిభను వెలికి తీసుకొచ్చింది.

విద్య: కుంభకోణంలోని ప్రభుత్వ కాలేజీలో చేరిన రామానుజన్ తన దృష్టి కేవలం గణితంపై కేంద్రీకరించడంలో ఎఫ్. ఎ. పరీక్షల్లో ఉత్తీర్ణుడు కాలేదు. ఆ తరువాత మద్రాసులోని పచ్చయ్యప్ప కళాశాలలో చేరి అక్కడ అధ్యక్షుడు ఎన్. రామానుజాచారి గణిత సమస్యలను కఠినంగా చెప్తుంటే రామానుజన్ వాటిని సులభమైన రీతిలో తక్కువ సోపానాలు సాధించేవారు.

గణితంపై రామానుజన్ ఆసక్తి:

- రామానుజన్ గారికి గణితం అంటే ఎంతో ఇష్టం.
- గణితంలో అమోఘమైన తెలివితేటల్ని ప్రదర్శించిన ఒక అరుదైన మేధావి శ్రీనివాస్ రామానుజన్.
- ఈయన శతజయంతి ఉత్సవాలు ఇటీవలే ఘనంగా జరిగాయంటే ఆయనకి విశ్వవ్యాప్తంగా ఎంత ప్రాచుర్యం ఉందో తెలియజేస్తుంది.
- చిన్ననాటి నుండే రామానుజన్ విచిత్ర ప్రశ్నలు వేసేవాడు.
- ఈయన బీజ గణితంలో సాధించిన సమీకరణాల వల్ల మూరల్, జాకోబ్ వంటి గొప్ప శాస్త్రజ్ఞుల కోవలోనికి చేరాడని కేంబ్రిడ్జిలో ఎంతోమంది చెప్పుకునేవారు.

1909లో జానకి అమ్మకను వివాహం చేసుకున్నారు. 1914లో లండన్ కి వెళ్లి రామానుజన్ గణితంపై పరిశోధన చేశారు, క్రొత్త సిద్ధాంతాలు కనుగొన్నారు. ఈయనకు ఎనలేని దైవచింతనం ఉండేది. దైవం, శూన్యం, అనంతం - ఇలాంటి అంశాల మీద ఉపన్యాసాలు కూడా ఇచ్చేవాడు. సైంటిస్ట్ అంటే నాస్తికుడే అయి ఉండాలని అనుకునే వారికి ఈయన ఉదంతం కనువిప్పు కాగలదు. రామానుజన్ గౌరవార్థం ఆయన పేరిట ఒక అవార్డును నెలకొల్పారు. మద్రాసు విశ్వవిద్యాలయంవారు రామానుజన్ ఇన్ స్టిట్యూట్ ను రూపొందించారు. ఇలా రామానుజన్ చాలా చెయ్యసాగారు. ఈయన అనారోగ్యంపాలు కాగా ఈయనని పరామర్శించడానికి ఒక వ్యక్తి

వచ్చారు. అతని కారు నెంబరుని ఈ విధంగా చెప్పవచ్చు అని చెప్పసాగారు.

ఆయన ఆశ్చర్యపోయాడు. ఈయన గణిత మేధస్సును చూచి. ఈయన సంసారం గడవడం కోసం “25” రూపాయల వేతనం మీద గుమస్తాగా చేరాడు. చిత్తు కాగితాలను కూడా బహు జాగ్రత్తగా వాడుకుంటూ గణితమే లోకంగా బ్రతికేవాడు ఈయన. గణితంలో ప్రదర్శిస్తున్న ప్రజ్ఞను చూచి ఏ డిగ్రీ లేకపోయినా మద్రాసు విశ్వవిద్యాలయం నెలకు 75 రూపాయలు ఫెలోషిప్ మంజూరు చేసింది. అప్పుడే రామానుజన్ 120 గణిత సిద్ధాంతాలను పొందుపరచి కేంబ్రిడ్జికి చెందిన గణిత శాస్త్రజ్ఞుడు జి.హెచ్. హార్డెయికి పంపాడు. హార్డే ఈ పనితీరుని గ్రహించాడు. చివరికి ఈయన 33వ ఏట కన్ను మూసారు.

కాలుష్యం : నేడు ప్రధాన సమస్య కాలుష్యం, జీవరాసుల జీవక్రియలను నష్టపరిచే వాతావరణంలోని మార్పులు కాలుష్యం. గ్యాస్, కొన్ని ద్రవ పదార్థాలు, ఘన పదార్థాలు, ఉష్ణోగ్రత, ధ్వని, రేడియేషన్ మొదలైన వాటి స్వభావం, పరిమాణం, నాణ్యతలు ప్రత్యక్షంగా కాని పరోక్షంగా కాని పర్యావరణాన్ని కలుషితం చేయగల స్వభావాన్ని కలిగి ఉండటమే కాలుష్యం. ఇవి రెండు రకాలు. అవి.

కాలుష్యం - 1) సహజ 2) కృత్రిమ

1) సహజ కాలుష్యం : ఈ సహజ కాలుష్యం అనేది ఎవరి ప్రయోగం లేకుండా సహజంగా ఏర్పడే కాలుష్యం.

2) కృత్రిమ కాలుష్యం : ఈ కృత్రిమ కాలుష్యం అనేది మానవుల ప్రతిభకు ఫలితమే ఈ కృత్రిమ కాలుష్యం.

వీటి వలన జంతువులు, మానవులు, వృక్ష సంపద, ఇతర సామాజిక ఆస్తులకు నష్టం కలుగుతుంది. జీవరాసుల ఆరోగ్యం, భద్రత సంక్షేమానికి ముప్పు వాటిల్లే ప్రమాదం ఉంటుంది.

కాలుష్యములలో రకాలు - 1) నీటి కాలుష్యం 2) నేల కాలుష్యం 3) వాయు కాలుష్యం 4) శబ్ద కాలుష్యం

1) నీటి కాలుష్యం : నీటి కాలుష్యం అనేది నీటి మరియు నీటి వనరులు కలుషితమైన ప్రక్రియ లేదా పరిస్థితి. ఈ వనరులు అనగా సరస్సులు, నదులు, సముద్రాలు, ఇంకా భూగర్భజలాలు.

- నీటి కాలుష్యం వలన మనం త్రాగే నీరు కలుషితం అవుతుంది.
- దాని వలన మనం అనారోగ్యం పాలు అవుతాయి.
- అలాగే జంతువులు కూడా అనారోగ్యం పాలు అవుతాయి.
- వాటిని సురక్షితంగా ఉంచాలి, ఫిల్టర్ చేసిన నీటిని త్రాగాలి.

నీటి కాలుష్యం జరుగకుండా ఉండే పద్ధతి

- నీటి కాలుష్యం జరుగకుండా ఉండాలి అంటే నదులలో కాలువలలో చెత్త పార వేయరాదు.
- నీటిలో పశువులకు స్నానాలు చేయించడం చేయరాదు.
- నదులలో బట్టలు ఉతకకూడదు, నీటిని శుభ్రంగా ఉంచాలి.

2) నేల కాలుష్యం : నేల కాలుష్యం రసాయన లేదా సహజ నేల వాతావరణంలో మార్పులు కలగటం వల్ల కలుగుతుంది. అసలు కాలుష్య కారకాలు ఘన, ద్రవ వాయు రూపంలో ఉంటాయి. పారిశ్రామిక విప్లవం వట్టణీకరణ వలన పర్యావరణం కలుషితమవుతుంది.

నేల కాలుష్యం జరుగకుండా ఉండే పద్ధతి

- నేల కాలుష్యం కాకుండా ఉండాలి ఉంటే ఎక్కువ ఫ్యాక్టరీలు అవి కట్టరాదు.
- నేల కాలుష్యం మానవ పనుల వలన ముఖ్యంగా జరుగుతుంది. వాటిని నిరోధించాలి.

3) వాయు కాలుష్యం : నైట్రస్ ఆక్సైడ్, క్లోరోఫ్లోరో కార్బన్లు, అమ్మోనియం, ఎగిరే బూడిద, ఏరోసాల్స్, హైడ్రోకార్బన్లు వంటివి వాయు కాలుష్యాన్ని తెస్తాయి.

ట్రైన్స్ పొగ, ఫ్యాక్టరీల పొగ

వాయు కాలుష్యం జరుగకుండా ఉంటాలంటే

- ఫ్యాక్టరీలను ఎక్కువ నిర్మించకూడదు, వాటి ద్వారా వాయు కాలుష్యం ఏర్పడుతుంది.
- చెట్లను నరకరాదు.
- ఆటో, కార్లు, మోటార్లు ఎక్కువగా వాడటం, సైకిల్ను ఉపయోగించాలి.

4) శబ్ద కాలుష్యం : శబ్ద కాలుష్యానికి ముఖ్యకారకుడు మానవుడు, మానవుడు టెక్నాలజీతో తయారుచేసిన వస్తువుల వలన శబ్ద కాలుష్యం కలుగుతుంది.

శబ్ద కాలుష్యం జరుగకుండా ఉండాలంటే

- శబ్దం వచ్చే వస్తువులను ఉపయోగించడం మానేయాలి.
- ఎక్కువగా కారు, బస్సులను తగ్గించి సైకిల్ను వాడాలి.
- శబ్ద కారకాలను నిషేధించాలి.

ఈ కాలుష్యాలు అరికట్టడం ఎలా?

- చెట్లను నరికి వేయకూడదు, చెట్లను పెంచాలి.
- సైకిల్ను ఎక్కువ ఉపయోగించాలి.
- నదులలో, కాలువలలో వ్యర్థాలు పాడేయకూడదు.
- విషవాయువులను సృష్టించే వాయువులను అరికట్టాలి.
- ఎక్కువగా మానవుడు తయారుచేసే వాటి వలన కాలుష్యం ఎక్కువ అవుతుంది.

పై వాటిని పాటిస్తూ కాలుష్యం రాకుండా కాపాడాలి.
