Minutes of the Meeting:

1. The Governing Body discussed various strategies to improve student admissions through targeted outreach programmes, including Junior College visits, awareness campaigns, and digital promotion. It was resolved to strengthen student retention by



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- implementing robust academic support systems, faculty and peer mentorship programmes, and skill development initiatives tailored to diverse learner needs.
2. Further, to enhance placement outcomes, the committee approved a plan to increase industry collaboration, conduct regular placement drives, and organize pre-placement training such as resume building, aptitude testing, and interview skills.
 3. The committee deliberated on the recommendations received from the UGC Standing Committee following the grant of extension of Autonomous Status to Sri Y. N. College for a period of 10 years (2024-25 to 2033-34). The Governing Body acknowledged the recognition and appreciated the contributions of the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) and all stakeholders. It was resolved to systematically implement the committee's suggestions, especially in areas such as academic innovation, governance, and outcome-based education.
 4. The Chair proposed organizing a Capacity Building Workshop for Faculty to address NEP-aligned curriculum design, learner-centric pedagogies, and digital competencies. A suggestion was also made to review and upgrade laboratory infrastructure in line with industry needs to support practical learning and research-based projects.






