Employers Feedback Analysis Report on Syllabus

For the Academic Year 2024-25

Employers' feedback on the syllabus for the Academic Year 2024-25 was systematically collected and analyzed to assess the industry relevance, practical orientation, and effectiveness of the curriculum in preparing graduates for professional roles. A total of 15 employer responses were received.

The analysis reflects a very positive employer perception of the syllabus across all parameters. A significant majority of employers strongly agreed that the syllabus is well structured, relevant to the programme level, and provides adequate scope for practical exposure and employability skills. Employers also acknowledged the effective integration of life skills, value-based education, and social responsibility, which are essential for holistic professional development.

The presence of only a small percentage of moderate responses and the complete absence of negative feedback clearly indicate that the curriculum is aligned with industry expectations and outcome-based education practices. Overall, the employers' feedback confirms that the syllabus is industry-aligned, learner-centric, and consistent with the quality benchmarks
