

Faculty Feedback Analysis Report on Syllabus
For the Academic Year 2024-25

Faculty feedback on the syllabus for the Academic Year 2024-25 was systematically collected and analyzed to evaluate the academic rigor, relevance, and effectiveness of the curriculum. A total of 73 faculty responses were received. The analysis reflects a strongly positive faculty perception of the syllabus across all parameters. A significant majority of faculty members strongly agreed that the syllabus is well structured, interesting, relevant to the programme level, and easy to understand. The feedback further indicates that the curriculum provides adequate scope for practical skills, employability skills, life skills, and value-based education. The minimal moderate responses and negligible negative feedback highlight the effectiveness of curriculum design and its alignment with teaching–learning outcomes. Overall, the faculty feedback confirms that the syllabus is academically sound, outcome-oriented, and aligned with institutional goals.
