We are delighted to present the Annual Report of the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) for the Academic Year 2024-25. This year has been marked by significant achievements and transformative initiatives aimed at fostering educational excellence and holistic student development at Sri Y. N. College.

I am extremely pleased to present the first quarterly report of our prestigious institution for the academic year 2024-25. Our college offers 19 programs at the UG level, four programs at the PG level, and four courses at the Intermediate level. In adherence to NEP-2020's emphasis on India's rich traditional wisdom, IQAC introduced Indian Philosophy as a multidisciplinary course, thereby enriching the curriculum with cultural depth for the UG batch of 2024-25.
