**Date: 24-10-2024****Action Taken Report(ATR) for the IQAC Meeting held on 19-06-2024**

1. The Student Induction Programme “Deeksharambh” was successfully conducted from 29th July 2024 to 4th August 2024 for all newly admitted Undergraduate (UG) students. The programme included sessions on college orientation, interaction with faculty and alumni, campus tour, and familiarization with institutional policies and student support systems. Thematic sessions on values, time management, and health awareness were also conducted. Feedback collected from students indicated that the programme significantly helped in reducing their anxiety and enhancing their understanding of college life.
2. A motivational talk titled “Building Better Careers: The Power of Discipline in Shaping Your Future” was successfully organised on 8th August 2024. The keynote speaker, Shri V. V. Lakshminarayana, IPS (Retd.), Former Joint Director, CBI, inspired students with his insights on discipline, values, and personal growth. The feedback received was overwhelmingly positive, with students appreciating the speaker's motivational and practical life lessons.

The workshop received enthusiastic participation from students and faculty, with positive feedback highlighting its practical relevance and engaging delivery.
2. The District Yuva Utsav was successfully organised on 7th December 2024 in collaboration with Nehru Yuva Kendra Sangathan, West Godavari District (Eluru), under the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports, Government of India. The event featured cultural performances, talent competitions, interactive panel discussions, and skill development activities. The meeting of the IQAC was held on 1st April, 2025 at 4:00 PM in the G.B. Meeting Hall to discuss the following agenda:

1. Discussion on strategies to improve Admissions through Outreach Programmes. Strengthening student retention through academic support, mentorship, and skill development initiatives. Enhancing Placement Outcomes through industry collaboration and regular Placement Drives.
2. Deliberation on the recommendations provided by the UGC Standing Committee following the extension of Autonomous Status for Sri Y. N. College for a period of 10 years, from the academic year 2024-25 to 2033-34.

Minutes of the Meeting:

1. The committee discussed comprehensive strategies to enhance student admissions through targeted outreach programmes, including school visits, digital campaigns, and alumni engagement. Further, it was resolved to strengthen student retention by implementing structured academic support systems, faculty mentorship, bridge courses, and skill development initiatives



tailored to student needs. In view of employability, the committee emphasized enhancing placement outcomes by fostering industry collaborations, organizing regular placement drives, and inviting companies for on-campus and virtual recruitment. Training sessions on resume writing, aptitude, and interview skills were also proposed.

2. The committee reviewed the recommendations provided by the UGC Standing Committee following the extension of Autonomous Status to Sri Y. N. College for a period of 10 years (2024–2034). It was resolved to implement the recommendations in a phased and strategic manner to ensure sustained academic excellence, improved governance, and greater autonomy in curriculum design and evaluation. A sub-committee was proposed to be constituted for preparing a roadmap to address and incorporate UGC's suggestions effectively.
3. The committee approved the organisation of a Faculty Development Programme (FDP) on “Dynamics of Teaching and Research Methodologies in Higher Education Institutions under NEP 2020”, scheduled from 16th to 21st June 2025. The FDP will focus on transformative pedagogies, research ecosystems, digital integration, and outcome-based education in line with the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020. Eminent resource persons from reputed institutions will be invited to deliver sessions.

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4. Regarding other matters, the committee resolved to implement a comprehensive Action Plan aimed at achieving academic excellence and driving institutional development. The plan will focus on strengthening teaching-learning practices, promoting research and innovation, enhancing faculty and student performance, and upgrading infrastructure. Departments were encouraged to align their annual goals with the institution's strategic objectives to ensure measurable outcomes and continuous improvement.
