Student Feedback Analysis Report on Syllabus

For the Academic Year 2024-25

Student feedback on the syllabus for the Academic Year 2024-25 was systematically collected and analyzed to evaluate the effectiveness, relevance, and learner-centric nature of the curriculum. A total of 605 student responses were received across various programmes. The analysis indicates a high level of student satisfaction with the syllabus design and delivery. A substantial majority of students either strongly agreed or agreed that the syllabus is well structured, interesting, adequate, and aligned with programme requirements. The feedback further reveals that the curriculum provides significant scope for practical skills, employability skills, life skills, value-based learning, and social responsibility. The minimal percentage of moderate and negligible negative responses reflect the effectiveness of curriculum planning and implementation. Overall, the student feedback confirms that the syllabus is outcome-oriented, relevant, and aligned with institutional and stakeholder expectations
