INTRODUCTION

A short-term internship is a temporary work-based training program offered for a limited period, usually a few weeks to a few months. It is mainly designed for students or freshers to gain practical knowledge, improve professional skills, and understand the real working environment. Through a short-term internship, a person gets an opportunity to apply classroom learning in practical situations, learn new techniques, develop confidence, and gain work experience. It also helps in building communication skills, teamwork, problem-solving ability, and career awareness. Therefore, a short-term internship is an important step in preparing for future employment and professional growth.

IMPLEMENTATION

- ❖ Every student should put in a minimum of 4 weeks to 8 weeks hours for the short-term internship during the summer vacation.
- ❖ Each class/section should be assigned with a mentor.
- ❖ The mentor should be a faculty member. Incentive could be given to the faculty mentors in terms of Academic Performance Indicators (API) scores. Or could even be made a compulsory in the service conditions laid down at the time of appointment.
- ❖ Implementation is the stage where the planned system or project is actually developed and put into use. In this stage, the design is converted into a real working system
- ❖ The log book has to be countersigned by the concerned mentor/faculty incharge.
- ❖ Evaluation to be done based on the active participation of the student and grade could be awarded by the mentor/faculty member.
- ❖ The final evaluation to be reflected in the grade memo of the student

- ❖ Minor project report should be submitted by each student. An internal Viva shall also be conducted by a committee constituted by the principal of the college.
- ❖ Award of marks shall be made as per the guidelines of Internship/apprentice/ on the job training.
- ❖ Positive impact on students' academic learning
- ❖ Improves students' ability to apply what they have learned in "the real world"
- ❖ Positive impact on academic outcomes such as demonstrated complexity of understanding, problem analysis, problem-solving, critical thinking, and cognitive development.
