- a) It is resolved to adopt and implement NEP 2020, I B.A, BBA, BCA, B.Com, B.Sc, (Theory and Model Question paper) Semester-II Multidisciplinary Course i.e., **"Indian History"** w.e.f. academic year 2025-2026 by making with 20% modifications to University syllabus as prescribed by the APSCHE and ANUR.
  - b) As per the Guidelines of APSCHE, the University did not choose History Minor in the Academic year 2025-2026. So there is no work load for I, II & V semesters. It is resolved and approved Skill development course i.e., **"Tourism Guidance"** for the 4<sup>th</sup> Semester to B.A, BBA, BCA, B.Com, B.Sc, students.

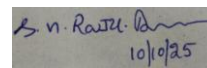
