I am extremely happy to present the annual report of our prestigious institution for the academic year 2019-20. In this context, I wish to express my sincere gratitude to the College Management, Teaching and Non-Teaching Staff for their excellent support extended during this academic year.

Prof. P. Suresh Varma, Hon'ble Vice Chancellor Adikavi Nannaya University, Rajamahendravaram attended as a Chief Guest in the College Graduation Day on 11-10-2019.

The members of the UGC Expert Committee for Extension of Autonomous Status, Prof. Kailash Chandra Sharma, Chairperson, Vice Chancellor, Kurukshetra University, Haryana State, Prof. B. N. Singh, Member, Professor & Former Head, University of Allahabad, Dr. R. Nagarajan, Member, Principal, AVCC College, Mannampandal, Tamil Nadu, Dr. D. Jyothirmai, University Nominee, AKNU, Rajamahendravaram, Mrs. C.K. Bhalla, Coordinating Officer, Under Secretary, UGC, New Delhi, visited our College on 3rd & 4th February 2020. The committee observed the activities of all the departments, Centers and Extension activities

of our College and appreciated the good initiative of the College and the motto of the college to Achieve Excellence.

Sri Y N College offers 9 combinations of courses at Intermediate level, 20 at UG level and 5 at PG level. The present student strength of the College is 3126 which includes 1803 in UG, 490 in PG, 742 in Intermediate, 91 in B.Ed. & D.Ed. In addition to that 200 Students in UG and 150 in PG joined in AU Distance Education during this academic year. As part of the curriculum, 15 certificate courses and 05 Add-on courses were conducted in August 2019. This year also special training in English Language Skills has been conducted to all 1st year degree and 1st year PG students by ILM, Bangalore throughout the year. The College Yoga & Meditation Center conducted classes to all 2nd year degree and 1st year PG students as a curriculum program.

As a part of the Quality Mandate, University Grants Commission (UGC) has set the goal to get every Higher Education Institution (HEI) accredited by the year 2022 NAAC. In order to achieve the goal, UGC has introduced a new scheme 'PARAMARSH' to enable Higher Education Institutions to upgrade their Academic Performance, enhance their overall Quality and get them accredited by NAAC.

We are happy to inform you that our College has been identified as a 'Potential Mentor College' by UGC under 'PARAMARSH' scheme. In this scheme our college has to give guidance to "5 Mentee Colleges" which are going for NAAC for the first time. This is a great opportunity and recognition to our esteemed college. A meeting was organised with NAAC Criterion Heads and members regarding 'Paramarsh' on 19-10-2019, which was addressed by Dr. Chinamilli Satyanarayana Rao, Secretary & Correspondent, Accreditation Ambassador to guide the NAAC criterion heads and members.

lam very happy to announce that we have been sanctioned Rs. 2 crores by HRD under Rashtriya Uchchatar Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA) Phase-II, Component-9 (Infrastructural Development Grant). This amount is being utilized for the construction of Boys Hostel in our college campus and to improve academic excellence by constructing Virtual Class rooms, Digital Class rooms, Labs and Library. Tenders for the construction of Boys hostel were called for by the State Govt. through-Andhra-Pradesh-Education-Welfare-And-Infrastructure Development-Corporation (APEWIDC) and it is in progress.

An orientation programme was organized on Minor Research Projects and Student Minor Research Projects which were sanctioned under RUSA 2.0 to the faculty on 20-6-2019. Ch.S.D.St. Theresa's College for Women (A), Eluru handed over RUSA 2.0 Projects (worth of 29 Lakhs) to the RUSA & IQAC Coordinators of Sri Y.N. College. The department of Physics, Electronics,

Chemistry, Management Studies (MBA), Mathematics, and Computer Science conducted national seminars and workshops. The Departments of English, Telugu, Sanskrit and Hindi jointly organized a two day International Seminar. Apart from these Faculty Development Programme and Students Support Training programmes were conducted under RUSA 2.0. Ten Minor Research Projects (MRPs) and 31 Students Minor Research Projects under RUSA 2.0 are ongoing and in progress. All these projects are in the completion stage.

An orientation programme was organized on "Continuous Professional Development (CPD)" to the newly appointed teachers on 4-8-2019.

The prestigious Alumni (old student of our college), Padma Bhushan Dr. Konidala Chiranjivi, Megastar, has given Rs. 50 lakhs from M.P. LADS for the development of the college. This amount has been utilized for the construction of Northern Side of PG Silver Jubilee Block 1st floor in Dr. C.S. Rao PG Centre, Sri Y. N. College.

We are conducting job oriented training classes to college students and unemployed youth in and around Narsapur through our college HRD center in collaboration with APSSDC.

In this academic year we have started two, 3 year B.Voc. Courses: Fashion Technology & Apparel Designing and Health Care & Nursing and one 1 year Diploma Course in Web Designing & Multimedia sponsored by University Grants Commission under National Skill Qualification Frame Work (NSQF) - New Delhi.

Prof. P. Suresh Varma, Hon'ble Vice Chancellor Adikavi Nannaya University, Rajamahendravaram inaugurated the Innovation & Entrepreneurship Development Centre (IEDC) on 11-10-2019.

One new course, B.B.A. is added to the feathers in the cap of Sri Y N College (Autonomous) at degree level in this academic year. This course was inaugurated by Sri K. Nageswara Rao, DSP, Narsapur and Prof. R. Prabhakar Raya, Former Dean, Pondicherry University on 4-7-2019.

The College has a very competent and experienced faculty. There are 20 Ph.Ds (Doctorates), and 20 M.Phils among the College Faculty. We registered a pass percentage of 73% in B.Sc., 86% in B.Com and 80% in B.A. and an average 78% during the Fifth Semester End Examinations in Nov, 2019. This year also Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) has been successfully implemented for third year students by selecting Cluster Electives.

The Independence Day was celebrated on 15th August, 2019 and the National flag was hoisted by Sri Ponnapalli Sree Rama Rao, Treasurer, Sri Y N. College on the occasion. On that occasion Ceiling Fans were distributed to the Kalyani Rehabilitation Centre, Peechupalem and Cash incentive to Bondamma Old Age Home, Narsapur by the College Management. As a part of Independence Day celebrations the Scholars Day was conducted. Prof. Thalari Vasu, Adikavi Nannaya University, Rajamahendravaram was the Chief Guest and released the College Newsletter 'Reflections'. Gold and Silver Medals, Merit Certificates were given to the meritorious

students of Intermediate, UG and PG courses. The Management of our College distributed cash incentives of Rs 5,000/- to Physically Challenged students. Special Prizes constituted by the eminent people of our town and retired faculty of our College were also distributed on that occasion.

Teacher's Day was celebrated on 05-09-2019. The Management of our college felicitated the Teaching staff, Dr. M. Nageswara Rao, Faculty of English (UG), Dr. Gandham Sri Rama Krishna, Associate Professor, Department of Management Studies (MBA) and Smt. Nallam Vana Priya, Faculty, Dept. of Economics (UG) on that occasion.

We also organized Telugu Language Day, Hindi Diwas and NSS Day programmes, Gandhi Jayanthi celebrations, Birthday Celebrations of Alluri Sitaramaraju, Sri Tanguturi Prakasam Pantulu and Sri Srinivasa Ramanujan, AIDS Day, International Yoga Day, Voters Day, etc., in this academic year.

Competitions were conducted in Sports, Literary and Cultural activities. Training classes in English Communication Skills, Personality Development, Disaster Management, Kishora Vikasam etc. were conducted.

The Republic Day celebrations were conducted on 26th Jan 2020. Sri G.V.K. Rama Rao, Vice-President of our college attended as Chief Guest and hoisted the National Flag and gave message on that occasion. The Management of our College distributed sewing machines to the poor women trained under Community Service Center of our college and on that occasion also distributed 1000 Cloth Bags to the participants.

Two of our students Mr. P. Jagadesh and Miss. Ch. Jahnavi Chowdary have participated in the Republic Day parade at New Delhi.

We conducted the College Annual Day on 12th March, 2020, for which Prof.Padala Raja Sekhar,Prof of Psychology, AdiKavi Nannaya University was the Chief Guest. We distributed cash awards sponsored by Padmabhushan Dr. B. V. Raju Foundation, Bhimavaram, which has been annually giving Rs.1 lakh towards the scholarships for the 50 poor & meritorious students of UG and PG since the academic year 2007-2008. Also, College has been giving 57 Endowment Prizes to the meritorious students in Degree & Intermediate.

I am glad to inform you that all the Departments of our college has conducted Student Seminars, Guest Lectures, and Quiz Competitions and assigned Project Works to students. Remedial classes for backlog students were conducted by all departments and coaching for competitive examinations for Final year Degree students is being conducted.

Miss. S.M.Maheswari participated in 6-Day MOOCs and MOODLE Training Programme at NITE Warangal from 30-11-2019 to 5-12-2019.

In this academic year various departments of our college, in addition to the classroom teaching, organized guest lectures by inviting university professors and experts from industries from time to time. They also conducted awareness programmes on socially and educationally relevant issues. The support services like NSS, NCC, HRD Centre, Innovation & Entrepreneurship Development Centre (IEDC), Women Empowerment Cell, Community Service

Centre, Yoga & Health Centre, UGC Gandhian Studies Centre etc., conducted various activities, orientation programmes, workshops, seminars, extension activities and service camps. Many of our faculty members are actively involved in research and publications. Our faculty members also participated in UGC/ICSSR sponsored National and International Seminars conducted by various universities and colleges in Andhra and Telangana States. 1st year PG students and 2nd year Degree students were given training in Yoga & Meditation Centre introducing in their regular curriculum.

Our college HRD Center (Skill Development and Placement Cell) is actively working to provide guidance for Career Development and Placements for our College students and unemployed youth. An Innovation & Entrepreneurship Development Centre is created this academic year to develop an entrepreneurial mindset in students. UGC sponsored Gandhian Studies Centre, Support services Women Empowerment cell, NCC (Army Girls and Navy), Fine Arts Association, Physical Education Department, College Community Service Centre etc., have been enthusiastically working in implementing effectively various service activities. College is also organizing, orientation and awareness programmes, guest lectures and workshops on socially relevant themes on all occasions.

I am thankful to the faculty members in particular and the Management in general, for their support and cooperation to fulfill the goals and objectives of the IQAC of our college as specified by the NAAC to attain the quality teaching in higher education.

It gives me immense pleasure to present the Academic Report of Dr.C.S.Rao P.G.Centre of our college for 2019-20 academic year.

Dr.C.S.Rao P.G.Centre which is the brain child of our beloved Secretary & Correspondent Dr.C.Satyanrayana Rao garu has successfully completed 30 years of academic excellence and is all set to attain the Autonomy status from the next academic year.

Ever since its establishment in 1990, the Centre has grown strength by strength under the nurturant Leadership of our Secretary & Correspondent and is now offering 05 P.G. Courses viz., M.A. English, MBA, M.C.A., M.Sc. Mathematics and M.Sc. Organic Chemistry. There are 473 students studying in all the P.G. Courses of which girls constitute 59%.

The Centre is equipped with well qualified & eminent teaching & non-teaching staff. Out of 31 faculty members, 6 have Ph.D., and 3 have M.Phil Degrees. Two members are about to attain Ph.D. in a complete months. 6 members got qualified in the APSET & UGC NET examinations.

During this academic year, 14 PG faculty members from all 5 PG Courses have participated and presented papers in 09 National & International Conferences and Faculty

Development Programmes conducted by the external colleges, Adikavi Nannaya University and AICTE in different parts of the State.

Mr.Ch.Venkateswara Rao of P.G. Organic Chemistry Dept., published 03 articles in the Scopus/NAAS indexed Journals.

Dr.G.Sri Rama Krishna authored a book entitled "HR Interview Techniques and HR Concepts" which is published by Vrindha Publishing House, Hyderabad.

The Research Centre of the MBA Department has become operational this year with the allotment of one full time Ph.D., scholar by the Adikavi Nannaya University to Dr.R.Pardhasaradhi, that is myself.

There is a steep increase in the research activity of the PG faculty members this year. The RUSA 2.0 scheme channelled through Saint Theresa's College for Women, Eluru granted 03 Minor Research Projects to the PG faculty which have been successfully completed and submitted.

Dr.R.Pardhasaradhi & Mrs.Sita Smitha of MBA Department executed a Minor Research Project on Motivation of Management College Teachers in West Godavari Dist.,




A Rally was conducted in the name of "VOICE OF FIRE" to inspire the youth on the eve of "Swami Vivekanada Jayanthi".

The National Mission on Education through Information and Communication Technology (NMEICT) Scheme meanwhile



Indians are among the most aggressive users of the Massive Open Online Courses (MOOCs). In October 2019, of the 2.9 million registered users of *Coursera*, more than 250,000 were from India. The Indian

registrations are second only to those from the USA.

GREAT MATHEMATICIAN SIR SRINIVASA RAMANUJAN

K. SRIJA 1st M.Sc(Mathematics)

CHILD HOOD: Srinivasa Ramanujan was born on 22nd December 1887 into a Tamil Brahmin Iyenger family. Madras Presidency(Now Tamilnadu), at the Residence of his maternal grand parents. His father Kuppuswamy Srinivasa Iyenger, originally from Tanjavur Distrit worked as a clerk in a Sari shop. His mother Komalatammal, was a housewife and sang at local temple. They lived in a small traditional home on Sarangapani Sannidhi Street in the town of Kumbakonam. The family home is now museum.

EDUCATION: On 1st October 1892 Ramanujan was enrolled at the local school. Later he was enrolled in Kangayan Primary School. Just before turning 10, in November 1897, he passed his primary education in English, Tamil, Geography and Arthmetic with best scores in the district. That year Ramanujan entered Town Higher Secondary School, where he encountered formal mathematics for the first time. Ramanujan was shown how to solve cubic equations in 1902; he developed his own method, the quartic. The following year he tried to solve quartic, not knowing that it could not be solved by radicals. When graduated from Town Higher Secondary School in 1904, Ramanujan was awarded the K.Rangaanatha Rao Prize for Mathematics. Ramanujan failed



his Fellow of Arts Exam in December 1906 and again a year later.

ADULTHOOD: On 14 July 1909, Ramanujan married Janaki, a girl his mother had selected for him a year earlier and who was ten years old when they married

In late 1910, Ramanujan was sick again. In 1912 Ramanujan moved with his wife and mother to George Town, Madras. In May 1913, upon securing a Reserch Position at Madras University, Ramanujan moved with his family to Triplicane.

by health problems throughout his life. His health worsened in England; possibly he was also less resillient due to the difficulty of keeping to strict dietary requirement of his religion there and because of wartime

rationing in 1914 - 18. He was diagnosed with tuberculosis and a reserve vitamin deficiency, and confined to a sanitorium. In 1919 he returned to Kumbakonam, Madras Presidensy and in 1920 he died at the age of 32.

MATHEMATICAL ACHIEVEMENTS: One of Ramanujan's remarkable capabilities was the rapid solution of problems. In 1918 Hardy and Ramanujan studied the position function P(n) extensively. They gave non - convergent asymptotic series that permits exact computation of the number of partitions of an integer. Ramanujan and Hardy's work gave rise to a powerful new method. In the last year of his life, Ramanujan discovered Mock Theta Functions. The number 1729 is known as the Hardy - Ramanujan number after a famous

visit by hardy to see Ramanujan at a hospital. In 1918, he was elected one of the youngest fellows in the history of Royal Society for his investigation in Elliptic Functions and the Theory of Numbers

RAMANUJAN'S NOTEBOOKS: While still in Madras, Ramanujan recorded the bulk of his results in four notebooks of loose leaf paper. The first note book haas 351 pages and some unorganised material. The second has 256 pages in 21 chapters and 100 unorganised pages, and the third 33 unorganised pages. In 1976 George Andrews rediscovered a fourth note book with 87 unorganised pages, the so called "Lost note book"





A BRIEF NOTE ABOUT JOHN MILTON

FAMILY BACKGROUND: John Milton was born in London in Bread Street, Cheapside. On the 9th December 1608. His father has been able to attain some prominence and make a comfortable fortune as a scrivener or notary and through the allied business of private banking or money lending-Possiblly the poet inherited from his father a disposition toword religious independence. He also owed to his father a debt in the way of music. The father was composer, not of the first rank but still of enough repute. The poet's life-long devotion to music is seen in the warmth of his adhesions to it. Milton's mother was well estimated and known for her charities. Milton had an older sister Anne and a younger brother, Christopher. Who became a lawyer.

education at home under private tutors and was then admitted to St. Paul's School, perhaps in 1620. At school he studied Latin and Greek, besides other subjets. One of his private tutors was a Scotsman, Thomas Young, to whom he later wrote two letters and the Latin Elegy IV (1627) in which he gracefully tells of introducing him to Latin poetry.

Milton was from childhood a great reader. This excessive reading proved to be the initial cause of his subsequent blindness.

AT CAMBRIDGE: In 1625, Milton Matriculated at Christ's College, Cambridge. He obtaind his B.A degree in 1629, and his M.A in 1632 at the same University. Milton wrote

abundant Latin verse and seven Latin prolusions. ("prolusions" were public speeches made by students to prove their learning and their rhetorical and argumentative powers)

THE PURITAN NOTE IN MILTON: Milton was essentially a puritan poet. He passed a tremondus moral fervour. He wanted to write poetry in the service of the god; he wanted to serve his maker with his in born gift of poetry. As he tells us in the Sonnet "On His Blindness" "The Ode on the Morning of Christ's Nativity" is "a puritan's tribute to Lord Christ. His greatest poem Paradise Lost, was written with the explicit intention of vindicating the ways of god to man. It is a poem based on the scripture. It has been discribed as the dream of a puritan fallen asleep over his Bible.

His Sonnets deal with patriotism, duty, music and subjects of political interest. He also wrote a few personal sonnets of which the best-known are "On his 23rd Birthday"and "On his Blindness". "Miltons Paradise Lost" is the greatest epic poem in the English litarature. Milton's imaginative control of his scenes extends even to illustrative details and excat features of language.

The period extending from 1625 to 1660 is generally described as "The Age of Milton" in English Literary History. This period marks the end of what is known as the Renaissance. The Age of Milton is filled with the political and religious strife of the regin of Charles I (1625-1649) and the triumph of Puritanism

He died on 8 November 1674, because of kidney failure.

HISTORY OF NEPAL KUMARI GODDESS:


Whilst the veneration of a living Kumari in Nepal is relatively recent, dating only from the recent 17th century, the tradition of Kumari Puja, or Worship, has been around for much longer. There is Evidence of worship taking place in Nepal for more than 2,300 yrs. It appears to have taken hold in Nepal in the 6th century. there is written evidence describing the selection, ornamentation and worship of the Kumari dating from the 13th century.

There are sevaral legends how the current tradition of Kumari began. Most of the legands, however involve the tale of the King Jaya Prakash Malla, The last Nepalese King the Malla Dynasty (12th - 17th century CE). According to the most popular legend, a king and his friend, the goddess Taleju approached

his chamber late one night as he played Tripasa, a dice game. The Goddess came along every night to play the game with the condition that the king refrains from telling anyone about their meetings.

One night, the king's wife followed him to his chamber in order to find out who the king was meeting so often. The king's wife saw Taleju, and the goddess was engraged. She told the king that if he wanted to see her again or have her protect his country, he would have to search for her among the Newari (Shakya) community of the Ratnawali, as She would be incarnated as a little girl among them. Hoping to make amends with his patroness, King Jayaprakash Malla left the palace in search of the young girl who was possessed by Teleju's spirit.

Even today, a mother's dream of a red serpent is believed to be a portent of the elevation of her daughter to the position of Royal Kumari.

- * The eagle has the longest life-span among birds.(20-30yrs)

- * Its old -aged and heavy wings, due to their thick feathers becomes stuck to it's chest and make it difficult to fly.

- * There the eagle knocks it's beak against a rock untill it plucks it out.
- * When it's new talons grow back, the eagle starts plucking it's old aged feathers.
- * And after five months, the eagle takes it's famous rebirth and lives for 30 more years.

Tip:-If you can't apologize in person consider calling on the phone or writing a card. Which


ever method you choose plan your words carefully.



TECHNIQUES:

BODY LANGUGES AND MANNERISM:- Stage directions are separate from spoken lines, but they work together to explain the events of plot and clarify each charector's emotions and personalities.

USE AND AWARENESS OF SPACE:- It's important to be aware not just of your marks on stage, but also of the actors who must interact with or move past you.

MIME:- Mime emphasises movement, actions and physical responses rather than dialogue and encorages participants to select moments to match the action and use of appropriate gestures and body language.

NARRATION:- Narration gives a spoken commentary on the action talking place during a drama. It's a useful technique in a number of ways.

Drama allows students to communicate with and understand others in new ways. It also help us to develop tolerance and empathy

Drama: Drama is a type of literature telling a story. which is intended to be performed to an audiance on the stage.

Using drama to teach English results in real communication involving ideas, emotions, appropriateness and adaptability; if short an oppurtunity to use language in operation which is absent in a conventional language class.

TYPES OF DRAMA:-

TRAGEDY: In the Greek sense, a play that ends with the death of atleast one of the main characters. In modern usage, it refers to a play that doesn't have a happy ending.







థామస్ ఆల్వా ఎడిసన్

థామస్ ఆల్వా ఎడిసిన్ ఫిబ్రవరి 11, 1847న మిలన్, ఓహియో, యునైబెడ్ స్టేట్స్ నందు జన్మించారు. తండ్రి శామ్యూల్ ఆగ్డన్ ఎడిసన్ జూనియర్ (1804–1896) మరియు తల్లి నాన్ని మాథ్యూస్ ఎడిసన్ (1810–1871)లకు 7వ మరియు చివరి సంతానం.

మానవజాతిని ప్రభావితం చేసిన విద్యుత్ బల్బు, ఫ్లోనోగ్రాఫ్ వంటి అనేక ఉకపకరణాలను రూపొందించిన ఒక గొప్ప అమెరికన్ శాస్త్రవేత్త మరియు వ్యాపారవేత్త. ఆర్ధికంగా నిలదొక్కుకోవడం కోసం రైళ్ళలో న్యూస్ పేపర్లు, స్వీట్లు అమ్మేవాడు. అతి చిన్న వయస్సులోనే టెలీగ్రాఫ్ నమూనా యండ్రాన్ని తయారుచేసాడు. డిసెంబర్ 25, 1874న 24 సంగల వయస్సులో రెండు నెలల ముందుగా కలుసుకున్న 16యేళ్ళ మారీస్టీల్ వెల్ ను వివాహమాడాడు. వీరికి ముగ్గురు సంతానం. బ్రతుకు తెరువుకోసం తన టెలీగ్రాఫ్ యండ్రాన్ని అమ్ముకున్నాడు.

1878లో ఎల్మ్రికల్ బల్బ్ ను రూపొందించాడు. 1877లో కనిపెట్టిన టెలిగ్రాఫ్, 1887–1889 మధ్య కాలంలో టైప్రెటర్, ఎల్మర్టిక్ పెన్, గ్రామ్ఫోన్, మోషన్ పిక్చర్ కెమేరా అలాగ ఎన్నింటినో ఈయన రూపొందించాడు. ఈయన అక్టోబర్ 18, 1931న వెస్ట్ ఆరెంజ్, న్యూజెర్సీ యునైటెడ్ స్టేట్స్ లో కన్నుమూసారు.
