IQAC Annual Report (2020-21)

The IQAC initiated several quality measures during 2020-21 as part of its efforts to sustain and enhance the academic quality and activities of the College. For this IQAC follows review meetings, feedback analysis and all activities aimed to ensure quality education for the students.

The Independence Day was celebrated on 15th August, 2020 and The Teachers Day was celebrated on 5th September, 2020. The College Management honoured seven senior Teaching Staff Members on that occasion.

The Republic Day was celebrated on 26th Jan, 2021. Sri Ponnapalli Sri Rama Rao, Treasurer of our College has attended as Chief Guest and unfurled the National Flag. He released the biannual Newsletter 'Reflections' at that moment. The Merit Certificates, Gold and Silver Medals were awarded to the meritorious students of UG and PG programmes. As part of the Community Service Programme, the Management has distributed 5 sewing machines to the destitute women trained by the College Swayam Krushi Centre. Special Prizes constituted by the eminent persons of our town and retired faculty of our College were also awarded to the students.

Our College Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) organised a One-day Staff Orientation Programme under 'Continuous Professional Development' (CPD) on 8th March, 2021 with Prof. K. Rama Mohan Rao, Vice-Chairman of Andhra Pradesh State Council of Higher Education (APSCHE) as resource person. Our staff members benefited much with his advices.

During this academic year 12 Online Webinars, Workshops and Seminars were conducted by all the academic departments of UG and PG. Project works were taken up by the students under the guidance of teaching staff. Remedial classes for academically challenged students for improving their standards were conducted by all the departments of our college. Coaching for competitive exams for final year degree students was facilitated this year also. Special training in English Language and Communication Skills has been given by a trained member from Institute of Language Management (ILM) Bangalore for all first year Under graduate and Post graduate students throughout the year.

In 2020-21 Academic year 46 faculty members of UG and PG Programmes participated in 123 online Faculty Development Programmes. Eleven Minor Research Projects (MRP) by our faculty members and Thirty two Student Research Projects by our students were successfully completed and submitted under RUSA 2.0 scheme sponsored by St. Theresa Women's College, Eluru during this academic year,

Dr. Gandham Sri Rama Krishna, Associate Professor, Department of Management Studies, Mr. Ch. Venkateswara Rao, Faculty member, Department of Organic Chemistry and other staff members published eight articles in the UGC referred and Scopus/NAAS indexed Journals. Many of our faculty members are actively involved in research and publications.

As a part of the Quality Mandate, University Grants Commission (UGC) has set the goal to get every Higher Education Institution (HEI) accredited by the year 2022. In order to achieve the goal, UGC has decided to introduce a new scheme 'PARAMARSH' to enable Higher Education

Institutions to upgrade their Academic Performance, enhance their overall Quality and get them accredited by NAAC. In this context, I am happy to inform that our College has been identified by UGC as a 'Potential Mentor Institution' to help and guide the NAAC aspiring Institutions. Under PARAMARSH Scheme, and Five Colleges of WEST and EAST Godavari Districts are selected as Mentee Colleges.

The Human Resources Development Centre (HRD Centre) of our college organised a One-day Orientation Programme for Career Guidance for Degree first year students on 3rd April, 2021 with Sri K. Rajakumar, Deputy Secretary, A.P. Assembly, Vijayawada, as resource person. Our HRD Centre has been actively working in bringing many national and International organizations for providing job opportunities for our students. A One-week online Orientation Programme on Competitive Examinations and Career Planning for U G & PG students was conducted by Sri Chaitanya IAS Academy, Hyderabad, on 6th June 2020. Online examination for final year degree 13 SRI Y.N. COLLEGE (Autonomous) MAGAZINE - 2020 - 2021 students was conducted by INFOSYS, Hyderabad on 12th December, 2020 and by WIPRO, Hyderabad, on 18th December 2020. The Centre organized a Demo Programme of Simply Science App organized by KEATS for faculty members on 11th February, 2021. I am happy to inform that sixteen students got placements during campus selections in our campus by Hetero Drugs, Hyderabad & Vijayawada on 27th March, 2021.

The Innovation & Entrepreneurship Development Centre of our college signed Memorandum of Understanding (MOUs) with Vaishnavi Vidya Enterprises, Tanuku on 26th November, 2020 and Suvarnabhoomi Developers Pvt. Ltd., Visakhapatnam on 18th January, 2021.

Our college initiated an Academic Collaboration with Sir C R Reddy College(A), Eluru on 27th October, 2021 in all Academic Collaborations and Student and Faculty exchanges would be mutually beneficial. The areas of cooperation may include Curriculum design, any desirable and feasible activity that would further the goals of each institution. Such interaction include cooperation in a variety of joint academic and educational activities such as:

- Joint conference, workshops, FDPs, Webinars(National and International) and training programmes.

Autonomous Status to the P.G.Centre:

The P.G.Centre after having completed 30 Years of existence has been granted Autonomous Status by the Adikavi Nannaya University with effect from 17th August, 2020. This is a remarkable achievement under the stewardship of our Secretary & Correspondent Dr.C.Satynarayana Rao garu. All the 5 P.G. Departments of M.A.English, M.B.A.,M.C.A., M.Sc. Mathematics and M.Sc.Organic Chemistry have constituted their Board of Studies, designed their syllabi and conducted the Board of Studies meeting through online. Subsequently the syllabi were approved by the Academic Council in its meeting held in our College on 27th March, 2021.

Sri G.Rangababu, Head of P.G. Mathematics Department has been appointed as the Addl.Controller of Examinations of the P.G. Departments in the wake of the autonomous status to the P.G.Centre.

Though the Govt. of A.P. excluded the P.G.Courses from the tuition fee reimbursement scheme, the admissions of our P.G.Centre during this academic year especially in MBA, MCA and M.Sc. Organic Chemistry are impressive. More than 90% of the seats are filled in these courses.

During this year Dr.A.V.Ramana of the Management Studies Department and Dr.K.Sushil Paul, Head of P.G. English department have been awarded Ph.D. degrees by the Andhra University and the Acharya Nagarjuna University respectively

Research Centre:

I am very happy to declare that Sri Y.N. College Research Centre in Management Studies has been allotted 9 Ph.D. scholars on the basis of APRCET19. Out of them three are the full-time scholars and six are the Part-time scholars. The Research guides of the Centre, Dr.R.Pardhasaradhi, Dr.Ch.Srinivas and Dr.G.S.Ramakrishna are allotted three scholars each.
