Agenda:-

4. To approve and ratify to allot 5 marks for Assignments and 5 marks for Viva-voce in each semester examination of I & II & III Semesters of I & II degree.


5. To approve and ratify to conduct each mid semester examination for 20 marks and should be reduced for 10 marks of I, II & III Semesters of I and II degree.

7. To Authorise the chairman, Board of Studies to prepare the list of Examiners for paper setting and valuation.




