- To discuss and approve the syllabi and model question papers for the BBA degree I, II and III years for the academic year 2022-23 by making appropriate modifications (above or equal to 20%) to the University syllabus.
- To discuss and ratify the syllabus for Bridge course for the newly admitted students.
- 3. To ratify the syllabus of the Certificate course titled 'Basic Computer Applications' for the academic year
- To discuss and ratify Programme Outcomes, Programme Specific Outcomes and the Course Outcomes of the B.B.A programme.
- 5. To discuss the modalities for conducting the Social Immersion Programme (Community Service Project) at the end of the 1st year B.B.A.
- 6. To discuss the modalities for conducting Internship/Project at the end of second year B.B.A.
- To discuss the modalities for conducting Internship during the VI semester for III year B.B.A students
- 8. To discuss the modalities and topics for conducting Seminars/Workshops.
- 9. To discuss the issue of online courses to be done by the students and staff.
- 10. Any other item.

RESOLUTIONS

- 1. a) The Syllabi of BBA I,II,III,IV Semesters that is designed by the AP State Council of Higher Education and Adikavi Nannaya University has been adopted by the Dept of Management Studies after making some modifications in 2020-21. The same Syllabi is decided to be followed for the 2022-23 academic year also.
 - b) The Syllabi of the BBA V Semester designed by the APSCHE and the Adikavi Nannaya University is thoroughly discussed by the members on the Board and approved.

The fifth Semester contains Six Skill Enhancement Courses (SECs) representing three streams, namely Human Resource Management, Marketing Management and Financial Management.

It is resolved to select two courses from the each stream as specified by the Adikavi Nannaya University. The Board of Studies has decided to offer the following courses in the BBA V Semester.

- 1. Talent Management (HRM)
- 2. Leadership (HRM)
- 3. Export and Import Management (MM)
- 4. Brand Management (MM)
- 5. Foreign Exchange Management (FM)
- 6. E- Payment System (FM)
- c) Nearly 70% changes have been made in the "Leadership" Course by deleting the redundant topics and by including several theories and Profiles of Successful Business Leaders. All the changes are approved by the Board of Studies.
- d) The model question papers of all five semesters are ratified.

- 2. The Board has approved a "Bridge Course" titled "Conceptual Foundations of Business" which is to be offered at the beginning of the 1st Semester in 10 days.
- 3. The Syllabus of the "Certificate Course" designed by the "Computer Science Dept" titled "Basic Computer Applications" is ratified.
- 4. The Programme outcomes, the Program Specific outcomes & Course outcomes for the BBA programme are discussed and approved.
- 5. It is resolved to conduct the Social Immersion Internship/Community Service Project at the end of the 1st year by allotting 10-15 students to each Teacher-Mentor. It is also resolved to advise the students to take up topics of Social significance in the Immersion Internship.
- 6. With respect to the 2nd year Internship, it is resolved to direct the students to do the Project Work for 8-10 weeks in any manufacturing or service organisations by choosing a topic in their specialisation area.
- 7. In view of the uncertainty prevailing with respect to the execution of the final year Six Months Specialisation Internship, it is resolved that the Government instructions are to be followed scrupulously.

If the Government instructs the Colleges to complete the $\,$ II year Project and the III year Internship in the 5^{th} Semester itself, then accordingly, the 5^{th} semester would be devoted for the Internship and the six theory Papers in the 5^{th} semester would be taught in the 6^{th} Semester.

- It is resolved to conduct two Workshops on Entrepreneurship & Intellectual Property Rights during December 22 – Feb 23.
- 9. It is resolved to direct the 2nd and 3rd year students to do Online courses through SWAYAM portal. Atleast one student has to register for and do one course in the 3rd semester/4th semester .Those students who successfully complete atleast one online course are decided to be given "Assignment marks" in the respective semester.
