IQAC Annual Report 2021-22

I take it as a privilege to present a concise report on the Academic, curricular, extra-curricular and co-curricular activities conducted by the College during the Academic year 2021-22. The IQAC initiated several quality measures during 2021-22, as part of its efforts to sustain and enhance the academic quality and activities of the College.

During this academic year, five Online Webinars, Workshops and Seminars were conducted by the departments of UG and PG. Project works were taken up by the students under the guidance of teaching staff. Remedial classes for academically challenged students for improving their standards were conducted by all the departments of our college. Coaching for Competitive Exams for Final year Degree students was facilitated this year also. Special training in English Language and Communication Skills has been given by a trained member from our College for all first year Under Graduate and Post Graduate students, throughout the year, In 2021-22 Academic year, our faculty members of UG and PG Programmes participated in online Faculty Development Programmes.

Seven articles were published in the UGC referred and Scopus/NAAS indexed Journals, by Dr. Gandham Sri Rama Krishna, Dean. Academic Affairs, Associate Professor, Department of Management Studies, Mr. Ch. Venkateswara Rao, Faculty member, Department of Organic Chemistry and Smt. B. Kabitha Rani, Department of English.

I am happy to inform that our College has been identified by UGC as a 'Potential Mentor Institution, to help and guide the NAAC aspiring Institutions, under PARAMARSH Scheme, and Five Colleges of WEST and EAST Godavari Districts are selected as Mentee Colleges. The IQAC of our College identified 7 teams of Faculty members and sent them to the Mentee Colleges and conducted Orientation Programmes on NAAC Accreditation Frame work.

In October, the College has entered into a Collaborative Agreement with Sir C. R. Reddy College, Eluru, for the Student-Exchange and the Faculty-Exchange Programmes. Consequently, the students and faculty from Sir C. R. Reddy College came to Sri Y N College, and Sri Y. N. College students and the faculty went to Sir C. R. Reddy College and organised the Faculty and Student Exchange Programmes.

On 28th September 2021, an Orientation Programme on the "Structural Enforcement of Accreditation Framework of NAAC" for the Mentee Colleges was conducted in our College Campus by inviting Dr. M. Satyanarayana, Rtd. Principal Government Degree College, Ramachandrapuram, and Lead Assessor of NAAC as the resource person.

On 9th October 2021, the College conducted the Academic and Administrative Audit through a Committee constituted for the purpose. The Audit Committee comprised 4 members, 1 external and 3 internal. Dr. Suravarapu Sankar, Rtd. Principal, A.N.R. College, Gudivada, and Lead Assessor of NAAC, headed the Audit Committee as the External Member. The Principal, The Academic & Research Advisor of the College, and the Dean, Academic Affairs are the internal members of the Audit Committee.

From 18th to 23rd October 2021, the IQAC of Sri Y N College (A) organised a One Week Faculty Development Programme(FDP) on "Professional Ethics & NAAC Revised Accreditation Framework" for the faculty members. The main

focus was on orienting the faculty members on the RAF of NAAC. 125 faculty members of the College participated in the FDP.

From 6th to 11th June 2022, One Week Faculty Development Programme(FDP) on "Paradigms of Outcome- Based Teaching and Learning" was organised by Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of the College. 125 faculty members took part in the FDP.

On 13th November 2021, Dr. K. V. Ramana Rao, Rtd. Principal, Govt. College, Ravulapalem, participated in the 'Intellectual Property Rights' Seminar organized by the IQAC of Sri Y N College, as the Chief Guest. He has conducted an Orientation Programme on the 'Revised Accreditation Framework of NAAC' to the faculty members, on 14-11-2021.

The institutional Life Membership is obtained for the PG Courses (Dr.C.S.Rao PG Centre) in Association of Indian Management Schools(AIMS) by paying Rs.30,880/- towards the membership fee and a sum of Rs.2,200/- is paid for the staff members' delegate fee in the Conferences.

NSS Units organised various Social Services Programmes and conducted Special Camps, at Bynapalem by Unit I, and at LB Cherla by Unit II. Various activities were performed on Telugu Language Day, Hindi Diwas, AIDS Day, International Yoga Day, Voters Day, Birthdays of Freedom fighter, Alluri Sitaramaraju, Social Reformer, Tanguturi Prakasam Pantulu, Mathematician, Sri Srinivasa Ramanujan, etc., this academic year. Our College organized various Guest lectures, Orientation and Awareness programs to students, teaching and non-teaching staff this academic year on socially relevant themes on all occasions. UGC sponsored Gandhian Studies Centre, NCC (Army Girls and Navy), Fine Arts Association etc., have been enthusiastically working in implementing effectively various supporting service activities.

We are thankful to the faculty members in particular and the Management and Principal in general, for their support and cooperation to fulfill the goals and objectives of the IQAC of our College as specified by the NAAC to attain the Quality and Quantity Teaching in Higher Education.
