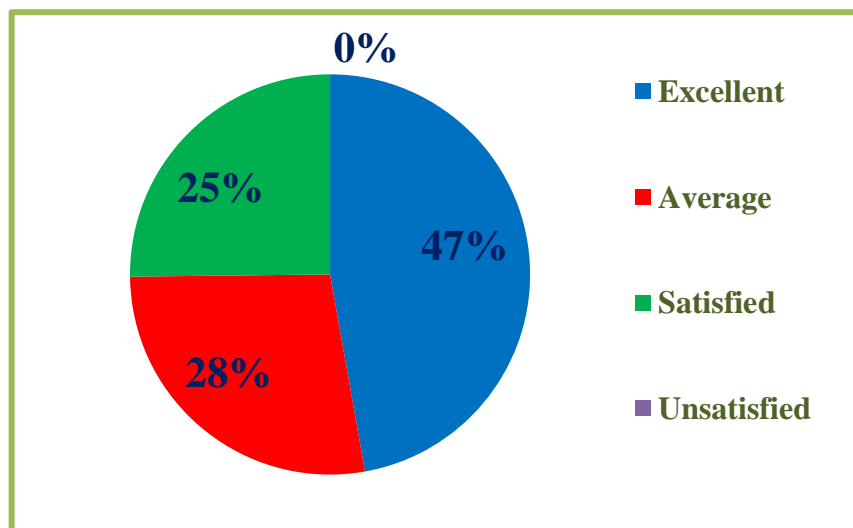

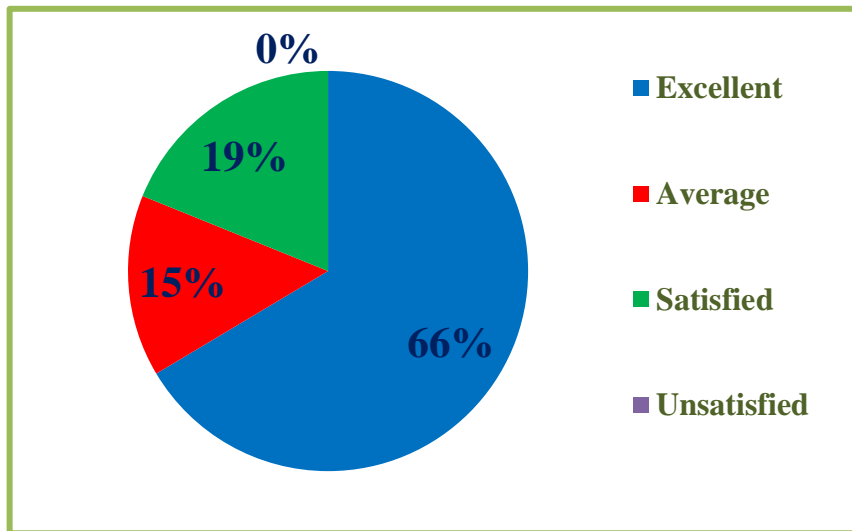
1. Are the teachers giving you sufficient time for any queries or clarifications?

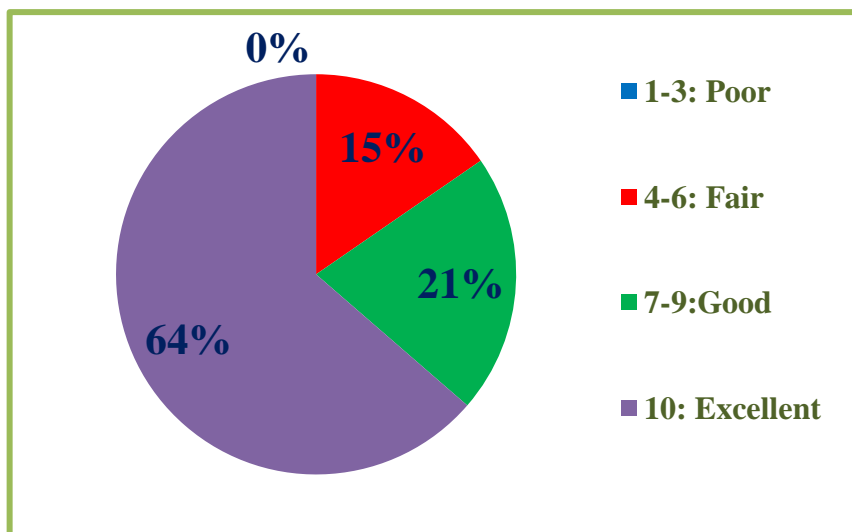
**2. Does the College have adequacy, Accessibility and Quality of Teaching-Learning Resources?**

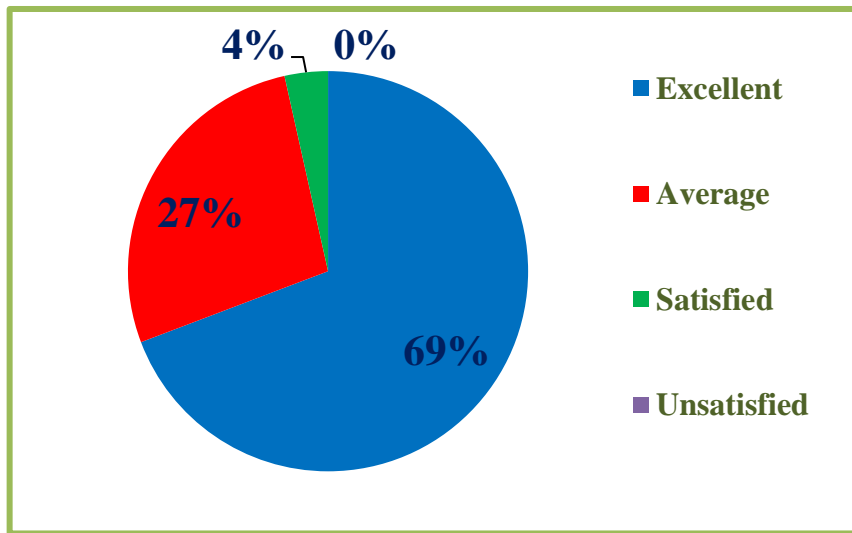
**3. How would you rate the teaching in this College on the scale of 1-10?**

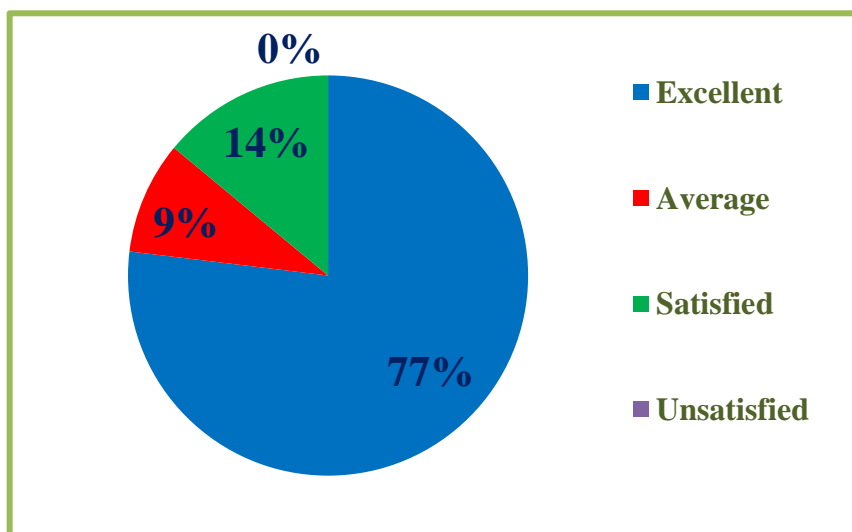
4. Are you explained about the course /curriculum properly by the teachers?

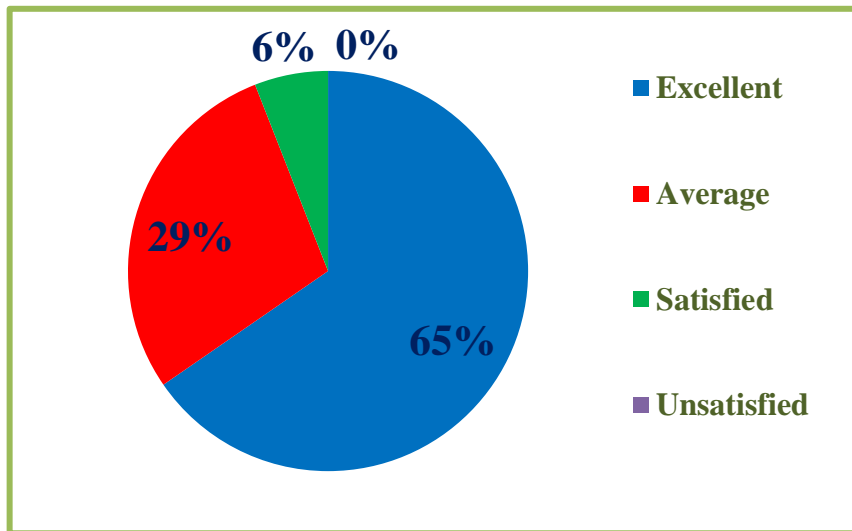
5. Do the teachers provide you with notes and teaching resources?

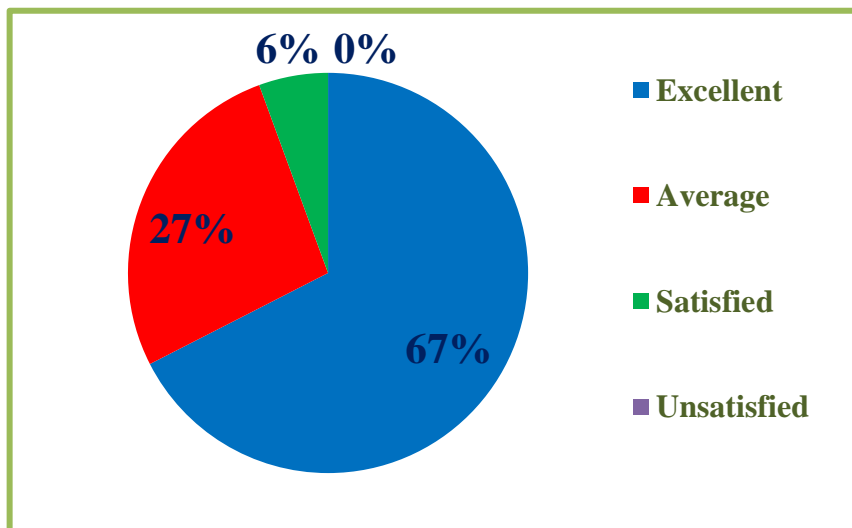
6. Are you satisfied with the Innovative teaching methods such as guest lectures, industrial visits, PPTs., Use of ICT tools?

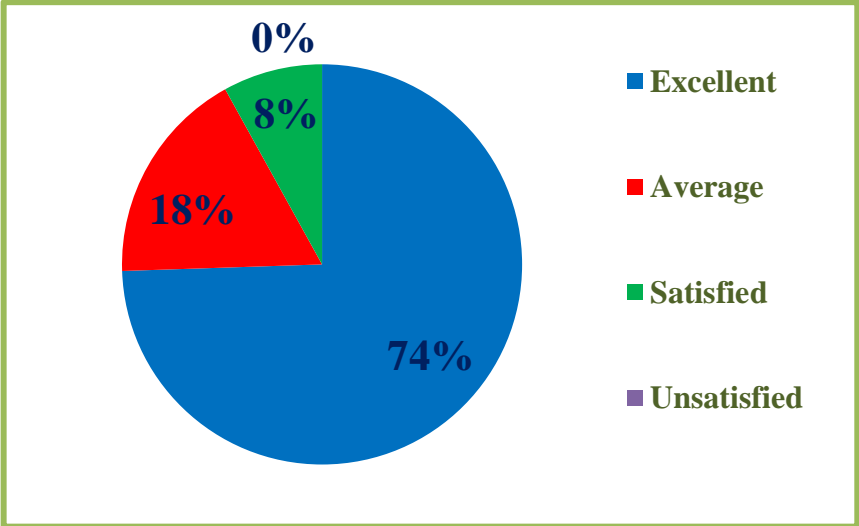
7. Are you satisfied with student centric methods such as various competitions conducted by the College?

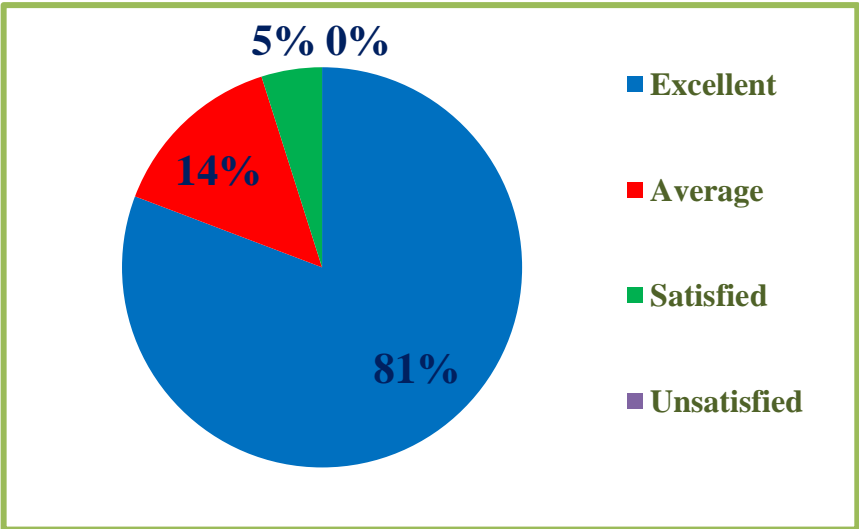
**8. Are you satisfied with the infrastructure provided by the College?**

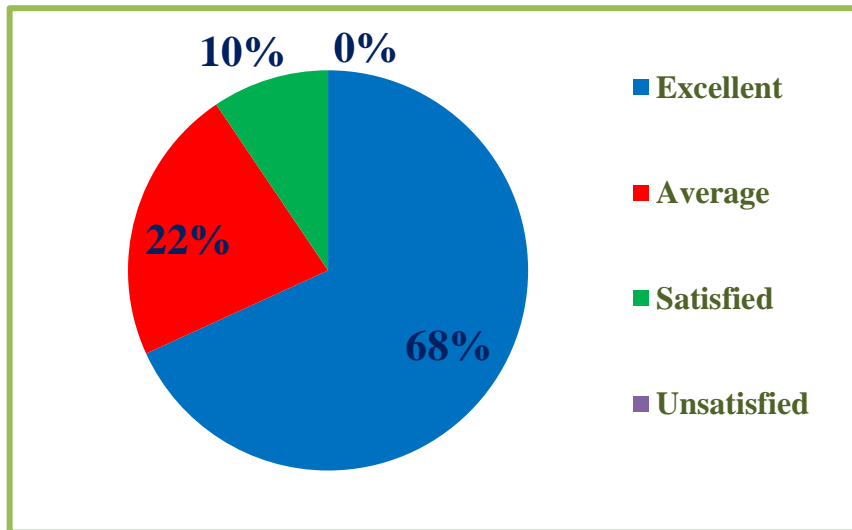
**9. Does the college provide transparency in conducting examinations and declaration of results?**

- 3. Suggestion:** Incorporate more environmentally-friendly practices into the College operations.


