

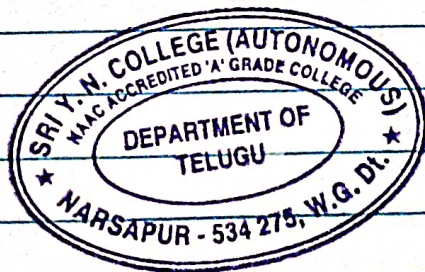
Resolutions:
