IQAC Annual Report 2022-23

I take it as a privilege to present a concise report on the Academic, curricular, extracurricular and co-curricular activities conducted by the College during the Academic year 2022-23.

The IQAC initiated several quality measures during 2022-23 as part of its efforts to sustain and enhance the academic quality and activities of the College.

The Independence Day was celebrated on 15th August, 2022 and The Teachers Day was celebrated on 5th September, 2022. The College Management honoured senior Teaching Staff Members on that occasion.

The Republic Day was celebrated on 26th Jan, 2023. Our College Ex-Officio President Sri. M. Surya Teja, Sub Collector, Narspur has attended as Chief Guest and unfurled the National Flag. The Merit Certificates, Gold and Silver Medals were awarded to the meritorious students of UG and PG programmes. As part of the Community Service Programme, the Management has distributed 5 sewing machines to the destitute women trained by the College SwayamKrushi Centre. Special Prizes constituted by the eminent persons of our town and retired faculty of our College were also awarded to the students.
