PRINCIPAL'S ANNUAL REPORT 2023 - 2024

Dr. Ch. Kanaka Rao Principal

I am extremely pleased to present the annual report of our prestigious institution for the academic year 2023-24. Our college offers 18 programs at the UG level, 5 programs at the PG level, and 4 courses at the Intermediate level. The present student strength of the College is 2351, including 1441 in UG, 429 in PG, 387 in Intermediate, and 94 in B.Ed.

The College boasts a highly competent and experienced faculty with 20 Doctorates and 12 M. Phils. We have achieved a pass percentage of 54% in B.Sc., 63% in B.Com.,76% in BBA, and 50% in B.A., with an average of 57% during the 6thSemester End Examinations in August, 2023. The National Education Policy (NEP) - 2020 is being implemented under which UG Programmes are now of 4 years duration with multiple entry and exit options with a focus on single Major and single Minor as per the choices of the students. The introduction of the Community Service Project (CSP) at the end of the first year, Short Term Internship at the end of the second year, and Semester Internship during the 6th semester is a notable addition to the regular curriculum.

The 11th, 12th and 13th Graduation Ceremony was conducted on July 22, 2023, with Chief Guest Prof. K. Padma Raju, VC of ANUR, and Guest of Honour Sri K. Surya Teja, IAS, Sub-Collector of Narsapur.

I am delighted to announce that our college has been accredited by NAAC with 'A+' grade, achieving a CGPA of 3.28 during the assessment for the fourth cycle. This accomplishment is especially rewarding after consistently maintaining an 'A' grade for three consecutive cycles. The peer team members conducted their assessment by visiting various departments, support services, research center, and interacting with all stakeholders during their visit to our college on 9th and 10th October 2023.

I am elated to present the Annual Academic Report of Dr.C.S. Rao P.G. Centre for the Academic Year 2023-24. The PG Centre earlier affiliated to the Andhra University got affiliated to the Adikavi Nannaya University since 2016-17 academic year. In 2020 it got its Autonomy. Presently the P.G. Centre has 05 P.G. Courses – M.A. English, M.B.A., M.C.A., M.Sc. Mathematics and M.Sc. Organic Chemistry.

I am very happy to inform that the Second Autonomous batch (2021-2023) of all the five PG Departments of Dr. C.S.Rao P.G. Centre has successfully passed out with about 96% Results. The third batch students of all the courses are presently in their IV Semester, awaiting the Semester-End and Course-End Examinations to be conducted in June, 2024.

In the present academic year, a Second Section of MCA with an intake of 60 was sanctioned BY AICTE, Ministry of HRD, Govt. of India. And almost all the seats of both the sections of MBA and MCA, totaling 240 all together, have been filled.

As the BBA and BCA courses were brought under the purview of the AICTE, the new development in the Academic Environment of our PG Centre is that from the next academic year, 2024-2025, the UG Courses of BBA and BCA will correspondingly be added to the MBA and MCA Programmes, to comply with the recent AICTE Stipulations. The AICTE has duly approved this reorganization of the Professional and Technical Programmes and Courses. Therefore, from the next academic year onwards, the Management Programme will have in it the Courses of MBA and BBA, and the Computer Applications Programme will have in it the Courses of MCA and BCA, with the approval of AICTE.

The PG Centre has wonderful ambience, resources and infrastructure, and other facilities for effective and efficient imparting of higher education. Separate buildings are there for the MBA, MCA and the other PG Courses. There is a spacious Air-Conditioned Seminar Hall, and an Air-Conditioned Conference Hall.

We have very good Science and Computer Laboratories. There are over 200 latest Computers, with LED Monitors, in the MBA and MCA Labs.

One of the most essential resources for an institution of Higher Education is The Library. We have a well equipped computerized library, comprising 22,000 volumes, and subscribing to 35 National and International Journals and Magazines belonging to various branches. We have also been subscribing to quite a few e-Journals. The faculty and students have free access to the Digitalized Section of the library with 15 Computer systems, and Internet facility.

I am extremely happy to inform you that our Research Centre, sanctioned by the Andhra University earlier, and later sanctioned by the Adikavi Nannaya University in the academic year 2016-17, has been doing well. The Centre facilitates Research Guidance to pursue M.Phil., or Ph.D., for up to ten research scholars, in the Departments of MBA. Dr. R. Pardhasaradhi,

Dr. G.S.Ramakrishna and Dr. Ch. Srinivas of MBA Dept., were granted Research Guidance-ship.


CLIMATIC CONDITIONS


ENTREPRENEURSHIPTHE SECRET OF GETTING AHEAD




CHANDRAYAAN-3
