Under the able stewardship of IQAC, Sri Y N College has attained a momentous milestone by securing the prestigious A⁺ Grade accreditation from the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) in the Fourth Cycle, on October 19, 2023. This recognition is a testament to our unwavering commitment for maintaining the highest standards of quality in education and academic practices.

In line with the transformative directives from the Andhra Pradesh State Council of Higher Education (APSCHE) and the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, IQAC spearheaded the conversion of existing Undergraduate (UG) programmes into Four-year Honours single-major discipline UG programmes. This structural reformation, implemented from the Academic Year 2023- 24, not only offers comprehensive knowledge and skills in chosen major disciplines but also fosters academic flexibility through a Multiple Entry and Exit System.
